**REGISTRATION PROCEDURES:**

Priority registration will begin for currently enrolled students on **Jan. 22nd**. All current students are given priority to re-enroll in their current classes. Please clearly list all classes your child intends to register for, and place an asterix (\*) next to any classes your child will be repeating from the fall. Open enrollment for remaining slots is open to the general public beginning on **Feb. 4<sup>th</sup>**. Designated Piano slots are saved throughout the academic year, but families must register again. Registration forms with check may be left in the G&P main office, or handed to a Community School staff member. Waiting list taken for all classes. Full payment, or a request for a payment plan is expected at the time of registration. **Make checks or money orders (no cash) payable to "Community Schools."** Your check is your receipt. If a class is full, you will be notified. Returned check fee is \$25 and must be paid within 48 hours to avoid disruption in your child's schedule. Please note there is a \$25 registration fee per child per school year.

- Children who need supervision before 3:15 must register for the Afterschool Activities Club (AAC) which meets from 2:25-3:15 (Fee: \$40.00/day covers the entire term). Please note which days your child will attend on his/her registration form.
- Classes will be held on Early Release Days. Special activities are offered from 12:30-3:15. Fee: \$30.00 per day. Please register in advance; separate registration form available.
- No refunds after the first week, but children may choose another course, space permitting. Partial refunds given for medical reasons. Refunds are not issued for missed classes.
- If a class is not fully enrolled, the class may be cancelled. You will be notified and given a refund, or an alternative class choice.
- Children must remain in the Community School Center while waiting for classes or pick-up.
- Pick-up is expected as soon as classes end. Late pick-up fees charged at a rate of \$1.00/minute, and must be paid within 48 hours. Children will only be released to those you have authorized. If there is any change in pick-up arrangements the director should be notified in advance via phone.
- Please notify us by phone if your child will be absent from the program: 617-349-6267.
- It is the parent's responsibility to notify their child's classroom teacher as to their Community School schedule.
- Children with restricted diets/allergies must indicate so on registration form and bring their own snack. Epi-pens must be provided to Community Schools in case of emergency.
- Linnaean Neighborhood Council meeting and supper held on first Tuesdays, bi-monthly at 5:30pm. Everyone welcome!
- Partial scholarships available to families who qualify. Please request a financial aid form. Income verification via the latest 4 pay stubs from each parent. All information provided kept confidential. Deadline March 15.
- If you have an outstanding balance with any Department of Human Service Program, your child's registration will not be accepted until all payments are made.
- Office hours 2:00-6:00 daily and Mondays & Thursdays until 7:00.
- Classes are not held on city holidays, snow days or on days the Cambridge Public Schools are closed.

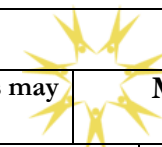
