REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- The registration form attached to the back of this program should be filled out and dropped off during the noted registration times below.
- Additional forms will need to be completed if new to the program.
- There is a once a school year application fee of \$25 per child due at registration for new students.
- Registrations must be returned to the Community School Office.
- Registrations are taken on a **first come first serve basis**.
- After these dates registrations will be accepted on a space available basis until **Friday, September 16th**.
- Class size limits will be strictly enforced.
- You will be notified only if the class you have chosen is full. If you do not hear from us you may assume your child is enrolled in the selected classes.
- Children's House classes are only available to 4 & 5 Year olds.
- Children may only register for classes in their appropriate age / school year group.

PAYMENTS:

Full payment is due at the time of registration, however a payment plan can be arranged with the director. Checks or Money Orders **(NO CASH)** should be made payable to: **Tobin Community School**. If you have an outstanding balance with any Department of Human Service Program, your child's registration will not be accepted until all payments are made. Class fees are based on the number of weeks a class meets. Early Release Days and holidays are not counted in the number of classes. **Returned checks** will be charged an additional \$25.00. Full payment must be made within 48 hours to avoid disruption in your child's schedule.

REFUNDS

If a class is not fully enrolled, the class may be cancelled. You will be notified and given a refund, or an alternate class may be chosen. We understand that there may be times when a class is not what your child expected. A full refund will be given if we are notified within 24 hours after the first class. Refunds will not be given if a child misses a class.

FINANCIAL AID

Partial scholarships are available. Please request a financial aid form from the director. Income verification in the form of W – 2 must be submitted with the application. All information provided will be kept confidential. Deadline for financial assistance is **Friday, September 16th**.

LATE FEE POLICY

Instructors are not responsible for children after the class ending time. All children must be promptly picked up at the end of class. There will be a late fee of \$1.00 per minute for each minute you are late after the scheduled pick up time. Late fees must be paid within 48 hours to avoid disrupting your child's participation in the program. Chronic lateness may result in suspension of your child's participation in the program. The office clock will be used to determine the time.

CHILD PICK UP & ABSENCES

Children will only be released to those you have authorized on your child's registration / emergency card. If there are any changes in the pick-up arrangements the director must be notified in advance. Only children ages 9 & up will be allowed to walk themselves home with parent/guardian permission. Please notify us by phone or email if your child will be absent from the program.
