The law requires that all dogs six months or older be licensed annually. The license period runs from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.

Licenses cannot be issued to persons under 18 years of age.

Applications may be processed online at <u>www.cambridgema.gov/doglicense</u>, the Animal Commission office at 344 Broadway, or you may license by mail (see #3 below).

If you no longer own a dog, contact the Animal Commission to ask them to remove you from their system.

To license a dog, please provide the following:

- $1. \ Current Rabies vaccination certificate with an expiration date (copies are sufficient)$
- 2. Proof of spay or neuter if not shown before
- 3. If licensing by mail include A SELF-ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE.
- 4. Fees:

(There will be a \$25 fee for any returned checks, and your dog will not be considered licensed until payment is made).

PLEASE READ: Check the Service Animal Box only if your dog is a Service Animal as defined under the American With Disabilities Act (ADA). This means any dog that is individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability. The work or tasks performed by a service animal must be directly related to the handler's disability.
