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P R O C E E D I N G S

PATRICIA LEWIS: A meeting of the pole and Conduit Commission will be held today, Thursday, October 18, 10:00 a.m. here at the Michael Lombardi Building, 831 Mass Ave, basement conference room.

So the new petition from Lighttower --

WILLIAM DWYER: No, not yet. We have the minutes from last month.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes. Motion to approve the minutes of meeting from September?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

NEW PETITION: LIGHTTOWER/LINE STREET

PATRICIA LEWIS: New petition for Lighttower Fiber Networks. It's Line Street -- I don't have to read the whole thing, do I?

GEORGE FERNANDES: I'll do that.

All right. So, this is Line Street

starting at Level (3) manhole, place one four-inch conduit at the property line of 1493 Cambridge Street, formerly the Cambridge Hospital, and Line Street, starting approximately 230 feet from Level (3) Manhole 0208, place (4) 1.25 inch HDPE conduits to the property line at 1493 Cambridge Street.

PATRICIA LEWIS: Is anybody here?

GEORGE FERNANDES: Have a seat.

Any questions?

WILLIAM DWYER: Purpose?

HERB BERTONI: New fiberoptic connections for the hospital.

WILLIAM DWYER: I know we've discussed this. You're just doing two construction connections right from Line Street?

HERB BERTONI: Yep.

WILLIAM DWYER: Lateral connections?

HERB BERTONI: Correct.

WILLIAM DWYER: There's going to be two of them, Herb, there's going to be one right up by the parking area and then another one down by -- closer to Cambridge Street?

HERB BERTONI: Yes.

WILLIAM DWYER: Public Works is okay with this project.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Conditions?

WILLIAM DWYER: Conditions will be city permits, follow all city specifications, follow SPOF regulations, and one more will be a meeting with DPW prior to construction, like an on-site meeting.

I think you've been to those Monday morning construction meetings before?

HERB BERTONI: Yes.

WILLIAM DWYER: Oh, yeah, you were there just two weeks ago. You should attend that. That's where you could actually catch up with the engineers to explain what you want to do, you now, Jay or myself, specifically, if you can't get us, otherwise, but also the week before you're going to do this, you should come in and bring it forward so other contractors in the area know what's going on.

HERB BERTONI: Okay.

WILLIAM DWYER: I'm good with it, George, and anything else you have.

GEORGE FERNANDES: No, I'm good with it.

Motion to approve?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDEZ: Yes.

CONTINUED: NSTAR ELECTRIC/BERKELEY STREET

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes. Second is continued from September 20th, NStar Electric for Berkeley Street, westerly at Berkeley Street a distance of approximately 58 feet of conduit from Pole 19 to Berkeley Place, southerly at Berkeley Street, a distance of 285 feet of conduit, install one new manhole, Manhole 29500.

So my understanding is this work would continue this year, done this year?

SUSAN BARROSO: Correct.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All the residents have been notified?

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: In regards to doing the work on their property so everything is okay.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Yes, we will be

working with the residents and hooking up underground.

GEORGE FERNANDEZ: Okay. And I understand Verizon does not have work to do on the street because they got poles from -- the only one I know is going is the pole in the driveway.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: The pole in the driveway is going away, the one in the back, so 5 and 4 are staying for now.

GEORGE FERNANDES: They have an agreement for feet for that pole?

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Comcast has an easement going with No. 5 Berkeley Street.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Correct.

GEORGE FERNANDES: So I think we should move this forward so that they can start this project before --

WILLIAM DWYER: Couple questions.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Sure.

WILLIAM DWYER: Give me a quick scope, capsule version of your scope of work that you need to do on Berkeley Place and Berkeley Street.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Yes. As it currently stands now, there's a few houses on Berkeley Street, No. 8 and 7 that fit underground. The other houses, 2, 4, and 6 are currently being fed overhead, and there's a pole in between 2 and 4, which is obstructing the guy's driveway pretty bad. It's got a lot of rises on it.

WILLIAM DWYER: Is that Berkeley Place or Berkeley Street?

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Berkeley Place. We want to get rid of that pole to free up his driveway. Actually, it's shared, two driveways. 2 and 4 are both driveways right now. Since there's all underground rises coming up, it's difficult.

By coming down from Berkeley Street putting in the conduit and a manhole where we put our transformers in there and feed 2, 4, 6 and 8 -- 6 is going to stay overhead for now -- 8 and 7 from that manhole and eliminate all those feeds coming from Craigie Street from the backyard.

WILLIAM DWYER: There's like five laterals if I count them right?

RICHARD SCHIFONE: 2 and 4 will become

new underground laterals, 6 and 7 are existing underground laterals that are going to be picked up into the manhole.

WILLIAM DWYER: Okay. After that excavation is done and the pipes are in the ground, what else is going to take place? What other work, construction work?

RICHARD SCHIFONE: We'll be pulling cable from the pole out on Berkeley Street, pulling new cable and putting transformers in the manhole.

WILLIAM DWYER: And then after that?

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Then we'll be done.

WILLIAM DWYER: Well, now looking at it -- that's what I mean. I'm looking at -- what you just told me, you've got to have a trench in the street, but it's not going to be repaved?

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Exactly. We'll be repaving the trench and the manhole area there, and where we have to break the manhole to pick up those underground laterals.

WILLIAM DWYER: That's what we need to have a meeting, "we" being "DPW." You need to tell one of the representatives, as you have in the past.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Our conduit group will be getting in touch with them before we do any digs and we'll lay out our plans.

WILLIAM DWYER: We definitely need to have an on-site meeting to make sure we're all on the same page.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Exactly.

WILLIAM DWYER: Depending on SPOF regulations allows us and you folks do, we'll get that all straightened out.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Exactly.

WILLIAM DWYER: Okay. I'm fine.

Conditions would be the exact same from the first one, Patricia, exact same conditions.

Who would be the rep, the on-site rep like during construction?

RICHARD SCHIFONE: It would be John Sutton.

WILLIAM DWYER: I'm familiar with John. We see him almost every week.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Or Mike Sweeney, one of those folks.

WILLIAM DWYER: Good. Terrific.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to approve?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

WILLIAM DWYER: I'm sorry. Verizon wouldn't be doing any work in the street, you don't think they need to, they just need conduit?

GEORGE FERNANDES: They're all fed from the backyard.

WILLIAM DWYER: That's right, the backyard, and Comcast is still working things out.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Yes.

WILLIAM DWYER: Everything on this page will be completed this season hopefully?

RICHARD SCHIFONE: That's our plan.

WILLIAM DWYER: You don't have to do any excavation -- I'm sorry to prolong this -- but you don't have to do any excavation or very little excavation from Berkeley Place and the intersection of Berkeley Street and Berkeley Place, just to make sure, you're not running all the way down to Craigie Street.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: No.

GEORGE FERNANDES: One pole.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Right.

WILLIAM DWYER: Just a little.

RICHARD SCHIFONE: No, I can understand.

WILLIAM DWYER: Well, you know me, huh?

RICHARD SCHIFONE: Anybody would be
concerned in that area.

WILLIAM DWYER: All right. Thanks.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to approve?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

WILLIAM DWYER: Thanks, George.

CONTINUED: NSTAR ELECTRIC/NORRIS STREET

GEORGE FERNANDES: Next is Norris Street
continued from the previous meeting. Waiting for
Verizon and Comcast to apply.

ANTHONY VATALARO: I spoke with the
property owner, and he said they're -- they won't
be ready for cable for at least two years if they
bring cable in at all.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Are they bringing
conduit in?

ANTHONY VATALARO: He said he's not ready for that. He said it's two years out.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Okay. Why don't you email me his phone number and I'll speak to him.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Okay.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Chances are he won't do it two years from now.

ANTHONY VATALARO: I can do that.

GEORGE FERNANDES: It would be foolish to try and do it two years from now. I'll speak to him.

Motion to continue?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes. Seconded, seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDEZ: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

CONTINUED: NSTAR ELECTRIC/LANCASTER STREET

NStar Electric continued from September 20 for Lancaster Street northwesterly approximately 115 feet west of Agassiz Street, about six feet of conduit.

And we were waiting for Comcast, Verizon and I think we have those before us.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Yeah. Comcast applied

last month.

SUSAN BARROSO: Verizon, as well.

GEORGE FERNANDES: They're all coming from the same pole.

WILLIAM DWYER: Yep.

GEORGE FERNANDES: So motion to approve?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

Patricia, the only conditions would be the exact same as we had for the other two.

PATRICIA LEWIS: Okay.

WILLIAM DWYER: So you can just --

PATRICIA LEWIS: Okay.

WILLIAM DWYER: Given those conditions, the permits, the specs and SPOF and a meeting with DPW, I second the motion.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All those in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Bill, can they request that meeting when they come in for a permit or -- I think the homeowner is gonna do the work. I don't know if NStar is doing their own.

WILLIAM DWYER: We can do that, sure.

ANTHONY VATALARO: He should request when

he gets the permit?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes, we can do that.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Do you want him to come in before the permit?

WILLIAM DWYER: No, they can come it, we'll do it at the same time. It isn't that big of a deal. It will be fine.

GEORGE FERNANDES: The other is NStar, Mass Ave.

SUSAN BARROSO: 2245?

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

WILLIAM DWYER: Is that the one you -- I put it somewhere else. Sorry, George. This one's going from Mass Ave, near the 7-11?

GEORGE FERNANDES: 7-11.

WILLIAM DWYER: Here you are (forwarding document).

GEORGE FERNANDES: This is a new late order for NStar Electric.

PATRICIA LEWIS: This is Verizon.

Oh, it's for NSTAR.

NEW PETITION: NSTAR ELECTRIC/2245 MASS AVE

GEORGE FERNANDES: NStar Electric and

2245 Mass Ave to place two four-inch PVCs from the building to a Manhole No. 2901 located on Day Street to the property.

WILLIAM DWYER: Patricia, same conditions, DPW has the same conditions that we had on the prior.

PATRICIA LEWIS: Is this approved?

WILLIAM DWYER: No, we haven't. This is part of what I would ask for. The conditions we had before.

PATRICIA LEWIS: The same conditions?

WILLIAM DWYER: Same thing, just bring it down the sheet here.

GEORGE FERNANDES: So NStar will have to submit an official application, and we'll get that for the next meeting and we'll recommend that the -- I'm going to recommend that we move forward on this because this is a renovation to this building, and they're upgrading the service and I believe construction is scheduled to be completed in November.

SUSAN BARROSO: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to approve?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All those in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

CONTINUED: NSTAR ELECTRIC/CLARY STREET

Okay. NStar Electric for Clary Street. This is continued from the previous meeting in September, and we're waiting for Verizon and Comcast.

ANTHONY VATALARO: I also have a phone call in to that property owner or the construction manager. He has not returned my call. I do know there's pole line on that street. I don't know if he's specifically requesting underground service.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Okay.

ANTHONY VATALARO: So I just -- I haven't been able to get in touch with him.

GEORGE FERNANDES: I think we should continue this.

WILLIAM DWYER: Okay.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to continue?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All those in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

CONTINUED: NSTAR ELECTRIC/HARRIS STREET

Next is NStar Electric for Harris Street continued from the September meeting and this is also waiting for Verizon and Comcast.

ANTHONY VATALARO: That's the same deal. The property owner or property -- the construction guy has not called me back, so I don't know what, if anything, they want us to do.

WILLIAM DWYER: That may cause us some problems, George. As of right now we're not -- the DPW is not allowing any final paving after the 31st of October, any top coating.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Oh, okay.

WILLIAM DWYER: We're maybe looking at next year.

ANTHONY VATALARO: They have a telephone.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Do you know if they're feeding both buildings?

SUSAN BARROSO: Just one building or the one building as well?

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes. My understanding is there's two buildings there, one is in Cambridge and one is in Somerville.

SUSAN BARROSO: I think just 31.

GEORGE FERNANDEZ: Just 31?

SUSAN BARROSO: Yep. Which is the one in Somerville?

GEORGE FERNANDES: There's one behind it that faces Beacon Street.

SUSAN BARROSO: Oh, we have service already behind 33.

GEORGE FERNANDES: The other side of Beacon Street.

SUSAN BARROSO: Yes.

WILLIAM DWYER: Finished by next month, construction-wise?

GEORGE FERNANDES: I don't know. I could move this. It was a question that come up because they were trying to feed both buildings from this pole. The other building is in Somerville and the same true is for --

WILLIAM DWYER: One option they have is to put down a temporary cable and hold a bond on them and they come back in, in the spring and repave it. So, it's not like -- it's just going to cost them more money, that's all.

GEORGE FERNANDES: You want to move it?

WILLIAM DWYER: Move it, you mean move it ahead?

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

WILLIAM DWYER: If you feel confident they can wrap things up.

GEORGE FERNANDES: I'm sure they can, it's just the issue is Comcast.

ANTHONY VATALARO: I mean, they haven't reached out to us at all. Even -- if they requested NStar service, they haven't requested anything from Comcast.

GEORGE FERNANDES: We can move it. I'll take care of it.

WILLIAM DWYER: Is that Clary Street or Harris Street?

GEORGE FERNANDES: Harris Street.

WILLIAM DWYER: Same conditions that we had prior.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to approve?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

PATRICIA LEWIS: Comcast, should I put in

there that you're waiting for them to call your construction guy?

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes, you could do that.

ANTHONY VATALARO: If he was looking for some underground service from Comcast, we would be put off until next year?

GEORGE FERNANDES: I'll address it when he calls.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Okay.

PATRICIA LEWIS: Will he get into contact with you?

GEORGE FERNANDES: Eventually he will be contacted. He's going to have to take out a permit, depending on the amount of he conduits that he's going to apply for. He's going to have to talk to me. If he does electric, fine. If he has any other conduits in there, I'm not giving him the permit.

WILLIAM DWYER: I know there's not much -- there's a lot of sidewalk out there, but he could run down the -- possibly run down the sidewalk. That would be an alternative for him too.

CONTINUED: NSTAR ELECTRIC/BLANCHARD ROAD

GEORGE FERNANDES: Next is NStar Electric continued from September for Blanchard Road. We're waiting on also Verizon and Comcast.

ANTHONY VATALARO: This one I do have to apply for. I did not -- I still haven't even seen it. He hasn't been able to meet me out there. I mean, I know what it is, but I need to get the application in.

GEORGE FERNANDES: So we can continue this?

WILLIAM DWYER: Uh-huh.

GEORGE FERNANDES: This actually is a pole in back of a sidewalk.

WILLIAM DWYER: Right.

GEORGE FERNANDEZ: Motion to continue?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

CONTINUED: NSTAR ELECTRIC/BRATTLE CIRCLE

Next is NStar Electric for Brattle Circle, new condition, southerly from Manhole 2971 at the intersection of Fresh Pond Parkway, a

distance of approximately 10 feet of conduit.
This work is to provide electric service for 220
Brattle Street.

SUSAN BARROSO: This is the pole that's
on 2 Brattle Circle?

ANTHONY VATALARO: Which one?

SUSAN BARROSO: 2 Brattle Circle.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Is that -- that's that
new complex?

SUSAN BARROSO: Yes.

ANTHONY VATALARO: There's a pole laying
out there, I think, going away. I'm not sure.

SUSAN BARROSO: Yes, it's going away. I
think it's a Verizon pole and they're --

ANTHONY VATALARO: Because they -- it was
unclear if that was gonna away or not. We would
feed from there if -- as opposed to doing the
underground, but I haven't gotten confirmation
that that's going away.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Okay.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Does the city know if
that's definitely going away or is that a
Verizon --

SUSAN BARROSO: It's a private pole.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Private property.

ELIZABETH KELLY: They're taking care of that with a relocation pole.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Is that pole going away.

ELIZABETH KELLY: I don't know that. All I know is that we're relocating one pole on a private -- what is a common driveway, but it's private, and then we're serving from Brattle Circle, so we don't have anything out on Brattle Street in the public way.

ANTHONY VATALARO: I would feed from the pole line if it's staying.

GEORGE FERNANDES: You'd feed what?

ANTHONY VATALARO: I would feed from the pole line.

GEORGE FERNANDES: If it's staying.

ANTHONY VATALARO: On the backside of the property. She said they were just relocating the pole.

ELIZABETH KELLY: But we're also putting the conduit on Brattle Circle, which is coming down here in one of the last petitions today, but not in Brattle Street.

ANTHONY VATALARO: If I can't go from the pole line, I would have to trench Brattle Circle.

GEORGE FERNANDES: You need to verify it.

ANTHONY VATALARO: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDEZ: We should continue?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yeah.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to continue?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

NEW PETITION: NSTAR ELECTRIC/FOSTER STREET

NStar Electric for Foster Street, conditions southeasterly from Pole No. 8 approximately 105 feet east of Sparks Street, a distance of approximately 10 feet of conduit. This is to provide electricity to 62 Foster Street.

Do you have applications from Comcast or Verizon?

ANTHONY VATALARO: For Foster Street?

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes, Foster Street.

ANTHONY VATALARO: It was approved last month.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Okay.

WILLIAM DWYER: We're talking about Foster Street, right?

ANTHONY VATALARO: Foster Street.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Foster, not Fawcett?

WILLIAM DWYER: Foster Street off of Sparks Street.

ANTHONY VATALARO: I don't have anything for Foster Street.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Okay. I think we should continue it.

WILLIAM DWYER: If they haven't heard anything, we have to, yeah.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to continue?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

POST: NSTAR ELECTRIC/MASS AVE AND ALBANY STREET

Okay. Next is NStar Electric for Mass Ave and Albany Street on September 20. Work order had to be changed and now it reads:
"Albany Street northeasterly from Manhole C23 approximately 370 feet west of Portland Street,

install approximately 187 feet of conduit."

This was approved and they're submitting the updating.

WILLIAM DWYER: Public Works is fine with this. The same conditions before, Patricia, with all the other approvals.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to approve?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

NEW PETITION: VERIZON/FAWCETT STREET

Next is Verizon. This is a new petition for Verizon for 86 Fawcett Street to place 80 feet of two four-inch PVC conduits in the roadway on Fawcett Street from previously approved manhole (not yet installed) crossing sidewalk to private property at No. 7 Fawcett Street.

GEORGE FERNANDES: They coming off a pole to a manhole to manhole to the property.

WILLIAM DWYER: Here it is. DPW doesn't have any issues.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Same conditions?

WILLIAM DWYER: Same conditions with the

approvals, yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to approve?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

NEW PETITION: VERIZON/OXFORD STREET

Next is Verizon, Oxford Street, place 90 feet of one two-inch PVC on Oxford Street from existing Pole 32, southerly within the roadway and crossing sidewalk to the property line of 135-137 Oxford Street to provide service.

WILLIAM DWYER: DPW has no issues, George.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Same conditions?

WILLIAM DWYER: Same conditions and restrictions of prior approvals, yeah.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to approve?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

NEW PETITION: VERIZON/BRATTLE CIRCLE

New petition. Next is Verizon for

Brattle Circle to install 60 feet of one four-inch conduit from existing Manhole 239 on Brattle Circle to private property at 1 through 7 Brattle Circle for service to new development.

WILLIAM DWYER: Again, no issues with DPW.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Same conditions?

WILLIAM DWYER: Same conditions and restrictions as the other approvals.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to approve?

WILLIAM DWYER: Seconded.

GEORGE FERNANDES: All in favor?

WILLIAM DWYER: Yes.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Yes.

Any other business?

Motion to --

LATE APPLICATION: VERIZON/TUDOR STREET

WILLIAM DWYER: Can we do Tudor Street?

GEORGE FERNANDES: Oh okay. This is a late application so Verizon will submit an application for the next meeting and this is for Tudor Street. To install two, two-inch conduits and two, four-inch conduits from Pole 4 to the property line at 17 Tudor Street.

WILLIAM DWYER: No issues from Public Works.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Conditions the same?

WILLIAM DWYER: Same conditions and restrictions of other approvals.

GEORGE FERNANDES: Motion to approve?
