## **NOTICE: BRICK SIDEWALK INSTALLATION** **Fayerweather (Brattle to Huron)**

Dear Resident,

This notice is to inform you of the upcoming brick sidewalk installation on Fayerweather Street (Brattle to Huron) as part of the **Huron B - Alewife Sewer Separation Project**. The City's contractor, Barletta Heavy Division, continues with sidewalk demolition and will begin brick installation the **week of April 25<sup>th</sup>**, beginning at the Gurney intersection and working towards Brattle Street, weather permitting. The contractor will complete one side at a time and this work is expected to take approximately 3-4 months to complete.

### **What to expect during sidewalk reconstruction:**

- Demolition of existing sidewalks
- Installation of new brick sidewalks
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways or entryways, the contractor will coordinate access directly with residents.
- Access to doorways will be maintained.
- Emergency vehicles will have access to all properties at all times.
- City services will continue uninterrupted.
- No parking will be posted during work hours (7-4).
- Road will be closed to through traffic and open to residents only.
