## **Manassas Avenue SURFACE RECONSTRUCTION Beginning the week of May 23<sup>rd</sup> , 2016**

Dear Residents,

Starting **the week of May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2016** (weather permitting), the City's contractor, Barletta Heavy Division, will be undertaking **surface reconstruction** of Manassas Avenue. Surface reconstruction includes roadway demolition and base course paving. Curb and sidewalk reconstruction and final paving will occur at a later date, for which you will receive a separate notification. Construction hours are 7am to 4 pm. This work is anticipated to take 3-4 weeks to complete.

### **What to Expect During Surface Reconstruction:**

- There will be **No Parking** allowed on the streets between the hours of 7 am and 4 pm. Please pay attention to posted signs.
- Vehicle traffic will be excluded during roadway demolition and paving, between the hours of 7 am and 4 pm. Signage and police details will be onsite to assist traffic.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways or entryways, the contractor will coordinate access directly with residents.
- Emergency vehicles will have access to all properties at all times.
- City services will continue uninterrupted.
