MASSACHUSETTS AVE ROADWAY MILLING

Garden St to Waterhouse St

Tuesday, October 21 and Wednesday, October 22 (night work)

9 PM to 5 AM

As part of the Cambridge Common/Flagstaff Park Improvements Project, MassDOT's contractor, Newport Construction, will mill the surface of the roadway on Massachusetts Ave from Garden St to Waterhouse St on **Tuesday, October 21 and Wednesday, October 22**, in preparation of paving. Work hours for the nighttime milling operation will be **9 PM to 5 AM** on both nights and Massachusetts Ave will remain open without detours.

What to Expect During Roadway Milling

- There cannot be any cars parked on the street during the milling operation. Please be sure to check "No Parking" signs to avoid being ticketed and towed.
- Vehicle access in and out of properties will be maintained.
- Signage and police details will be in place to assist neighbors, but drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes.
- Paving is tentatively scheduled for Saturday, October 25 and Sunday, October 26 (daytime). An additional paving notice will follow.
