HENRY STREET ROADWAY GRINDING

Thursday, October 27

As part of ongoing improvements, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corp., will grind the surface of the roadway on Henry St from Pearl St to Brookline St on **Thursday, October 27**, to prepare the street for paving. Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, and Henry St will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters. We expect the work to take 1 day to complete.

What to Expect During Roadway Grinding

- The road will be closed to through traffic during work hours, and reopened at the end of the work day.
- Access to properties will be maintained, and all sidewalks will remain open.
- There cannot be any cars parked on the street during this work. Please be sure to check "No Parking" signs to avoid being ticketed and towed.
- Final paving is scheduled for next week. An additional notice confirming the paving date will follow.
