PEMBERTON STREET ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION

Rindge Ave to Fairfield St

As part of ongoing improvements, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corp., will begin reconstructing the surface of the roadway on Pemberton St on **Wednesday, August 17 (weather permitting)**, to prepare the street for paving. Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, and Pemberton St will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters.

What to Expect During Roadway Reconstruction:

- On Wednesday, August 17, crews will begin on Pemberton St at Fairfield St, and work their way towards Rindge Ave.
- There cannot be any cars parked on the street during this work. Please be sure to check "No Parking" signs to avoid being ticketed and towed.
- Signage and police details will be in place to assist neighbors, but drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes.
- Paving is tentatively scheduled for Wednesday, August 24. An additional notice confirming the paving date will follow.
