PAVING NOTICE FOR UPLAND RD

Final Paving Scheduled for Wednesday, August 31

The City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corp, will pave Upland Rd from Raymond St to Huron Ave, and the intersection of Upland Rd and Huron Ave on **Wednesday, August 31**. Paving is expected to begin around 12 PM and continue until complete. This is the final paving for Upland Rd.

What to Expect During Paving

- Upland Rd from Raymond St to Huron Ave, and the intersection of Upland Rd and Huron Ave will be closed on **Wednesday, August 31** during paving, and reopened at the end of the work day.
- There cannot be any cars parked on the street during this work. Please be sure to check "No Parking" signs to avoid being ticketed and towed.
- Vehicle access in and out of properties will be restricted during paving. Please plan vehicle trips accordingly. All sidewalks will remain open.
- Signage and police details will be in place to assist neighbors, but drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes.
- Paving is weather dependent, and may be rescheduled due to heavy rain.
