Fawcett Street Construction Resumes

Monday, March 31

Dear Fawcett Street Neighbor,

Next week, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corporation, is expected to resume work on the Fawcett Street Reconstruction Project. Crews will mobilize to 130 Fawcett Street to begin constructing a Bioretention structure. The Bioretention structure will help remove contaminants and sedimentation from stormwater runoff in the area. The roadway directly in front of 130 Fawcett Street will be closed to through traffic. This work is expected to take 2 weeks to complete. Once crews have completed the installation of the Bioretention structure, crews will focus their efforts on completing the roadway and sidewalk restoration phase of the Fawcett Street Reconstruction Project.

What To Expect During Construction

- General work hours will be 7am – 4pm, Monday thru Friday. If any night or weekend work is required by the contractor, you will be notified with a separate notice.
- “No Parking” signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; please be sure to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways or entryways, the contractor will coordinate access directly with residents and businesses.
