PAVING NOTICE FOR JFK STREET

*South Street to Mt. Auburn Street
Night Paving, Wednesday, November 2
7PM to 7 AM*

The City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corp., will pave lower JFK St (South St to Mt. Auburn St) on the **evening of Wednesday, November 2**. Paving operations will begin at 7 PM on Wednesday night and continue until 7 AM, Thursday morning.

What to Expect During Paving

- JFK St (South St to Mt. Auburn St) will be closed intermittently to vehicle traffic during the overnight hours on **Wednesday, November 2**. Message boards and signage will be in place to direct drivers.
- There cannot be any cars parked on the street during this work. Please be sure to check "No Parking" signs for exact dates and times to avoid being ticketed and towed.
- Sidewalks will remain open during paving operations.
- Signage and police details will be in place to assist neighbors, but drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes.
- Paving is weather dependent, and may be rescheduled due to heavy rain.
