Kinnaird Street Reconstruction Project

Dear Neighbor,

As part of the City’s Street and Sidewalk Reconstruction program, Kinnaird Street is scheduled to be reconstructed from Putnam Avenue to River Street. In April 2014, a community meeting was held to begin the design process for Kinnaird Street. The City is anticipating that this work will begin around spring 2015.

Over the past couple of months, city staff has spent time evaluating the existing conditions on Kinnaird Street and analyzing the suggestions that were brought forth to staff at the first community meeting. **On Thursday, June 26 at 6:30pm, the Community Development Department and the Department of Public Works will be hosting a second community meeting at the Moore Youth Center (located on Gilmore Street).** We encourage you to attend, as we value the feedback we receive from Cambridge residents and businesses.
