## Kinnaird Street Construction Begins

Monday, April 20

Dear Neighbor,

On Monday, April 20, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corporation, will begin to replace the water main and install catch basins on Kinnaird Street from Putnam Avenue to Jay Street. Crews will begin replacing the water main at the Putnam Ave intersection and make their way south on Kinnaird Street. The replacement of the water main and installation of catch basins are expected to take one (1) month to complete. Towards the end of this utility work, crews will begin to reconstruct the roadway and sidewalks within the project area.

### **What to Expect During Construction**

- General work hours will be 7AM to 4 PM, Monday-Friday.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted at least 24 hours in advance of construction; please be sure to check posted signs for exact dates and times.
- Detour: Beginning Monday, April 20, the Putnam Ave intersection will be closed and Kinnaird Street residents will be detoured to Bay Street or Howard Street. Please be on the lookout for signage.
- When work occurs directly in front of driveways or entryways, the contractor will coordinate access directly with residents.
- City services will continue uninterrupted & emergency vehicles will maintain access at all time.

### **Project Coordination**

Over the next few months, the MLK School and the Kinnaird Reconstruction Projects will be working simultaneously. The goal is to have the Kinnaird Street Reconstruction Project (Putnam Ave to Jay Street) completed by September 2015, in advance of the school opening this fall. Over the past few months, staff from both projects have been coordinating on a weekly basis and will continue to do so until the work has been completed. **Please refer to the reverse side of this notice to view work limits for both projects.**


