MYRTLE/MAGNOLIA CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Sewer Installation on Myrtle Ave Begins Monday, April 2

Dear Resident,

On **Monday, April 2**, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corp., will add a second crew in the neighborhood and begin sewer main installation on **Myrtle Ave**. During work hours, Myrtle Ave will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters.

Intermittent detours will be place and both Myrtle Ave and Magnolia Ave will operate with 2-way traffic during work hours only. Police details will be onsite to assist neighbors. Please refer to the detour map on the reverse.

Project Schedule

- Crews will mobilize on Myrtle Ave on Monday, April 2.
- Sewer installation on Myrtle Ave is expected to take 2-3 weeks to complete.
- Work hours are 7 AM to 4 PM, Monday through Friday.

What to Expect during Construction

- During this work, Myrtle Ave will be closed to through traffic but open to abutters.
- Please note there will be intermittent detours in place during work hours, but residents will have access to properties at all times. See detour map on the reverse.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times. Traffic signs and police details will be in place to assist neighbors.
- Pedestrian access and access into properties will be maintained at all times, but may be restricted in certain ways. All sidewalks will remain open.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times and all city services will continue.


