(toys, buckets, laundry baskets)
- ✓ Stiff Plastic Containers
- ✓ Spiral Cans (potato chip, nut cans)

### PAPERS

- ✓ Books (rip off hard covers)
- ✓ Cardboard Boxes
- ✓ Coffee Cups (empty, no Styrofoam)
- ✓ Frozen Food Boxes (if it rips)
- ✓ Newspapers with Inserts
- ✓ Magazines & Catalogs
- ✓ Paper Bags
- ✓ Paperboard  
(cereal & tissue boxes, paper towel rolls)
- ✓ Phone Books & Junk Mail  
(remove free samples)
- ✓ Pizza Boxes (empty, oil stains OK)
- ✓ Shredded Paper  
(in a clear plastic or a paper bag)
- ✓ White & Colored Paper  
(staples, paper clips, spirals OK)
- ✓ Wrapping Paper
