

*Modify Section 7.20 to read as follows (addition shown in underline):*

**7.20 ILLUMINATION**

In Residence A, B, C, and C-1 districts no outdoor floodlighting or decorative lighting, except lighting primarily designed to illuminate walks, driveways, outdoor living areas, or outdoor recreational facilities, and except temporary holiday lighting in use for not longer than a four week period in any calendar year, shall be permitted. Any permanent lighting permitted by the preceding sentence shall be continuous, indirect, and installed in a manner that will prevent direct light from shining onto any street or adjacent property. All outdoor lighting shall be installed in conformance with the applicable requirements of the Cambridge Outdoor Lighting Ordinance.

*Modify Section 6.46 to read as follows (addition shown in underline, deletion in strikeout):*

**6.46** *Lighting.* Off street parking facilities which are used at night shall be provided with adequate lighting installed and maintained in such a manner so as not to reflect or cause glare on abutting or facing residential premises nor to cause reflection nor glare which adversely affects safe vision of operators of vehicles moving on nearby streets. ~~A recommended standard for lighting is a minimum intensity of one (1) foot candle on the entire surface of the parking facility.~~ All outdoor lighting shall be installed in conformance with the applicable requirements of the Cambridge Outdoor Lighting Ordinance.

*Modify Section 6.93 to read as follows (additions shown in underline):*

**6.93** Off street loading bays may be enclosed in a structure and must be so enclosed if located within fifty (50) feet of a Residence District where the use involves regular night operation, such as that of a bakery, restaurant, hotel, bottling plant, or similar uses. Any lighting provided shall be installed in a manner that will prevent direct light from shining onto any street or adjacent property. All outdoor lighting shall be installed in conformance with the applicable requirements of the Cambridge Outdoor Lighting Ordinance.
