




# **TAC Updates**



  - Recruitment for new members new members to start in December 2021/January 2022



# **City Updates**

### **City Projects**

- Looking at following bus priority corridors and will be coming to upcoming meetings to share more information
  - South Mass. Ave Harvard to Memorial Drive, focused on Central to Mem. Drive
  - **Concord Avenue** Transit signal priority Harvard to Belmont Line
- **River Street Reconstruction** Continuing work on Carl Barron Plaza design options with urban design staff, processing feedback

# **MBTA & Commonwealth Updates**

### **MBTA Green Line Extension**

- Provided update on project progress in December 2020
- Union Square station access from Cambridge will not be finished until 2022 as a result of US2 developer delays in constructing elevator
- Lechmere station trending to reopen summer 2021
  - North Station-Lechmere bus bridge would end
  - Route 80 would be consolidated with Route 88
  - Route 88 would be diverted to serve Sullivan Station
  - Routes 69 and 87 would remain serving
  - EZRide to serve station area

# **Ongoing MBTA Initiatives**

- Bus Network Redesign ongoing
  - Summer 2021 outreach on network alternatives
  - Winter 2022 outreach on final alternative and phased implementation
- MBTA/MassDOT Silver Line Extension Alternatives Analysis to begin in earnest in February
- MBTA proposal to renovate North Cambridge facility in order to replace electric trackless trolleys with battery-electric buses
- New Red Line vehicles first trainset entered service on December 30, 2020

## **Commonwealth Bond Bill**

- Legislative authorizations, but not a requirement to spend on projects
- Waiting on Governor's signature
- Transit line items
  - Planning for Inner Belt Bridge
  - Planning, design, and construction of new Alewife Station garage
  - Planning, design, and implementation of bus priority in/out of station
  - Planning, design for Route 2 highway BRT pilot (Acton-Cambridge)
  - Planning, design, and construction of new CambridgePark Drive/Rindge Avenue intersections
  - Planning study of Red Line extension to Arlington Heights
