

MBTA Service Restorations

- MBTA restored ferry services on May 22
 - Charlestown Rowes Wharf Weekdays + weekends
 - Hingham-Hull-Boston Weekdays + weekends
 - Hingham-Boston (Direct) Weekdays-only
- MBTA will restore all weekend commuter rail service on Saturday July 3
 - Schedules are not yet published

MBTA Service Restoration - Buses

- MBTA planning to restore some bus service on June 20
 - **Restore** Route 68 all day service
 - Restore separated routes None
 - Increase peak frequencies Added trips on the following routes
 - Route 47 Weekday trips, including peak
 - Route 62/76 Weekday trips, including peak
 - Route 70 Saturday and Sunday trips
 - Route 91 Weekday midday trips, Saturday and Sunday trips
 - Increased frequencies and route diversions
 - Route 71/73 Weekday, Saturday, and Sunday trips; temporary terminal on Mount Auburn
 - Route 77 Weekday, Saturday, and Sunday; temporary terminal on Brattle
 - Route 78 Weekday, Saturday, and Sunday; temporary terminal on Brattle
 - Other routes have minor changes to trips

Presentation: City & TAC Updates

MBTA Green Line Extension

- Project is an estimated ~70~75% complete
- Public meeting confirmed for June 30, 2021
- Partial opening planned for October 2021
 - Reopening with service to Lechmere and Union
 - No fare gate line at GLX stations, including Lechmere; stations will have a "fare paid" area
 - Fare vending machines to also serve as fare validation machines
- Service to Medford/Tufts is planned to open in December 2021
- Elevator access for Union station delayed until 2022

MBTA "Building Back" – In progress

- Many new construction projects through December will involve route/line, busway, and station closures resulting in alternate bus stop locations, bus shuttling, or alternate travel.
 - June-August: Harvard Busway closed alternate surface bus stops
 - August October: Fitchburg Line weekend closures for safety systems – bus shuttles
 - September to December: Red Line weekend closures for signals, tunnel repairs, floating slabs – bus shuttles




Cycling Safety Ordinance




Volpe MIT Development

 - Review application and communicate comments to staff or planning board, as individuals




Alewife Park (IQHQ) (#2)


