

MBTA Updates

MBTA Green Line Extension

- Project is an estimated ~75~80% complete
- Partial opening planned for March 2022
 - Reopening with service to Lechmere and Union
 - Rail-replacement shuttles to remain until service to Lechmere begins
- Service to Medford/Tufts is planned to open in May 2022, remains TBD
- Elevator access for Union station delayed until mid 2022
- 24 new trolleys purchased to accommodate increased ridership
- Out-of-service train testing has begun between North Station and Union Square
