Proposed Interest Areas

1. City projects and policies

Cycling safety ordinance, DPW 5-year street and sidewalk, dedicated bus lanes, new TDM ordinance proposal

2. Coordination with other city groups

Students at Cambridge Schools, other committees and boards,

3. MBTA projects and policies

Regional bus priority, regional rail planning, fare-free transit, North Cambridge garage conversion, bus electrification

4. MBTA service planning

Bus network redesign, Late-night service, bus reliability
