The Planning Board of the City of Cambridge will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, September 17, 2019 at 8:30 p.m. in the City Hall Annex, Second Floor, 344 Broadway, Cambridge, Massachusetts on a petition by the City Council to amend the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Cambridge by creating new sections in Section 19.20 – Project Review Special Permit. The Special Permit review would include new requirements for the review of electrical service and gas service infrastructure and that findings be made that a permit shall only be granted if the proposed project would not cause undue adverse impacts on the residents and the environment by requiring extensive additional utility infrastructure to the city, including, electrical, gas, sewer, stormwater and any other utility service. *(this zoning petition has been refiled)*
