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ARTICLE 19 PROJECT NARRATIVE

This is an application by Tyler Court Ltd. for a Special Permit to allow for the construction of a multifamily residential building at 33 Cottage Park Avenue containing sixty seven (67) dwelling units with parking for 71 motor vehicles and 83 bicycles. The property is situated along the Linear Park in North Cambridge and lies within Special District 2.

The project will involve the redevelopment of the Fawcett Oil distribution facility and offices and portions of the former Norberg Greenhouses lot into a generously landscaped site containing a single structure with principal entrances on both Whittemore Avenue on the west and Cottage Park Avenue on the east. The new building will consist of a three and four story Mansard design totaling approximately 83,500 square feet. Vehicular access to the property will be from Cottage Park Avenue and Whittemore Avenue. Parking facilities will consist of surface parking lots on the eastern and western edges of the site and a controlled access parking facility abutting the building containing at grade and covered parking.

The landscape will result in the creation of a park like setting throughout the site with significant and open green spaces dedicated to active play as well as passive enjoyment. Enhanced pedestrian access to the abutting Linear Park will be created at the end of Cottage Park Avenue. The remainder of the Norberg Greenhouse lot has been subdivided into four separate lots of 5,000 square feet and are under separate ownership. Those lots are intended to be sold and developed as single or two family dwellings. They are not included in this application.






COTTAGE PARK AVENUE, CAMBRIDGE MA PROPOSED GROUND FLOOR PLAN

COTTAGE PARK AVENUE, CAMBRIDGE MA PROPOSED SECOND FLOOR PLAN

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

COTTAGE PARK AVENUE, CAMBRIDGE MA PROPOSED THIRD FLOOR PLAN



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

PLANTING NOTE

- 1. ALL PLANT MATERIAL SHALL CONFORM TO THE MINIMUM GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED BY THE AMERICAN STANDARD FOR NURSERY STOCK PUBLISHED BY THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION NURSERY WIFN, INC.
- ANY PROPOSED SUBSTITUTIONS OF PLANT MATERIAL SHALL BE MADE WITH MATERIAL EQUIVALENT TO THE DESIRED MATERIAL IN OVERALL FORM, HEIGHT, BRANCHING HABIT, FLOWER, LEAF, COLOR, FRUIT AND CULTURE. PROPOSED SUBSTITUTIONS WILL ONLY BE CONSIDERED IF SUBMITTED WITH ENUMERATED REASONS WHY SUBSTITUTIONS ARE PROPOSED.
- 3. VERIFY ALL EXISTING UTILITY LINES PRIOR TO PLANTING AND REPORT ANY CONFLICTS TO THE OWNER OR HIS REPRESENTATIVE.
- 4. NO PLANT SHALL BE PLANTED BEFORE ACCEPTANCE OF ROUGH GRADING.
- 5. ALL PLANT MATERIALS SHALL BE GUARANTEED FOR ONE YEAR FOLLOWING DATE OF FINAL ACCEPTANCE.
- 6. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CLEARLY MARK LIMITS OF CLEARING AND LIMITS OF SELECTIVE PRUNING AND THINNING, FOR REVIEW BY THE A/E PRIOR TO ANY CLEARING OPERATIONS.
- 7. ALL TREES NOTED FOR CLEARING AND SELECTIVE PRUNING AND THINNING SHALL BE EXECUTED BY A LICENSED ARBORIST.
- 8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL TAKE ALL MEASURES NECESSARY TO PROTECT EXISTING VEGETATION THAT IS TAGGED BY THE A/E, "TO BE SAVED".
- 9. ALL TREES TO BE SAVED SHALL BE PROTECTED WITH A SNOW FENCE AND HAY BALES CIRCLING THE TREE AT A MINIMUM DISTANCE OF 1/2 THE CANOPY.
- 10. THE A/E RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ADJUST FINAL GRADES IN THE FIELD TO SAVE EXISTING VEGETATION.
- 11. PLANT QUANTITIES NOTED IN THE PLANT SCHEDULE ARE APPROXIMATE AND ARE PROVIDED FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF THE CONTRACTOR. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FURNISHING AND INSTALLATION OF ALL PLANT MATERIALS NOTED ON THE PLANTING PLAN.
- LOAM AND SEED ALL DISTURBED AREAS UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED.
- 13. REGRADE STOCKPILE AREA AFTER REMOVAL OF SURPLUS MATERIALS (SEE SITE WORK SPECIFICATIONS). LOAM AND SEED THE DISTURBED AREA.
- 14. TOPSOIL STRIPPED FROM THE SITE AND PROPERLY STOCKPILED PRIOR TO APPLICATION MAY, UPON APPROVAL OF THE ENGINEER, BE USED FOR PREPARATION OF LAWNS AND PLANTING BEDS. IT SHOULD BE FREE OF LAGGE (ONE (1) INCH OR GREATER) COBBLES, ROOTS, OLD SOD, TRASH, WOOD OR OTHER CONTAMINANTS AND BE OF A FRABLE CONSISTENCY AND SUTRIBLE FOR PLANT GROWTH.
- 15. PROMDE SOIL TEST REPORTS FOR ONSITE TOP SOIL TO BE REUSED AND FOR LOAM BORROW TO BE IMPORTED. SOIL TEST REPORT SHALL INCLIDE USDA TEXTURAL CLASSIFICATION TEXTURAL SIEVE ANALYSIS, AS WELL AS NUTRIENT ANALYSIS, AND INCRO-NUTRIENTS.
- 6. THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR SMALL FIRMES! LOAM BORROW/ TOPSOIL. LOAM SMALL BE FERTILE, FRANCE, NATURAL AND PRODUCTIVE TOPSOIL OF GOOD CLAY-LOAM TO SANDY LOAM TIPE. LOAM SHALL BE WITHOUT ADMIXTURE OF SUBSOIL AND SHALL BE REASONMELY FREE OF STOKES, LUMPS, ROOTS, STICKS INVASIVE SEED OR STOCK AND OTHER FOREGI MATTER. LOAM SHALL NOT BE WORKED OR APPLIED IN A MUDDY OR WET CONDITION.
- 17. PROVIDE SOIL AMENDMENTS AS DIRECTED BY THE A/E BASED UPON THE FINDINGS OF SOIL TESTS PROVIDED FOR EXISTING TOP SOIL TO BE REUSED AND OR IMPORTED MATERIAL.
- 18. ALL PLANTING BEDS TO BE FILLED WITH SOIL AND CROWNED ABOVE ADJACENT LAWN OR IMPROVED AREAS. ALL PLANTING BEDS TO BE MULCHED WITH AGED PINE BARK MULCH TO A DEPTH OF THREE (3) INCHES.
- 19. CAUTION SHALL BE USED NOT TO EXTEND MULCH LAYER ABOVE SOIL LEVEL AT TRUNKS/STEMS OF INSTALLED PLANT MATERIAL.
- 20. PROVIDE FIVE (5) FOOT DIAMETER MULCH CIRCLE AROUND ALL INDIVIDUAL TREE PLANTINGS AND CONTINUOUS MULCH BED AROUND SHRUB PLANTINGS.
