- Amends paragraph 3(c.) of the Decision by deleting the existing wording and substituting therefor the following:
- "c. Execution of an agreement with the City of Cambridge requiring a yearly contribution to the maintenance of Lechmere Canal Park, as provided in the Developer Agreement dated October, 1983, as amended. The agreement shall provide that failure to make the required payment shall constitute a lien on the property."

Minor Amendments to PUD Special Permit #38 Canal Park Associates - Parcels C and F

Modify the Decision of PUD Special Permit #38 by adding the following paragraphs:

- Allow as a permitted use of Parcel F the surface parking of 140 cars to serve the parking needs of the Davenport Building, 25-43 First Street until the Lechmere Canal UDAG parking garage is completed.
- 2. a) Amend the schedule of construction as approved in the Decision to permit/require initiation of construction of the approved building on Parcel F by April i, 1988, or
 - b) if said UDAG parking garage is not completed by April 1, 1988 require a major amendment to the PUD Special Permit #38 to incorporate the 140 parking spaces granted in paragraph #1 above on a permanent basis into the building to be constructed on Parcel F. Such amendment shall be secured and construction shall be initiated by April 1, 1988. Any building approved as a result of such a major amendment shall be in conformance with the design guidelines specified in the Developer Agreement and as reflected in the currently approved building design.
