Hello Sarah -


The attached photos show the trim / moulding that we propose to match.

- * Stile measurements on each window is 1 and three quarter inches
- * Rail measurements are shy of 3 inches
- * Flat trim around each window is 6 inches and the band Moulding is 3 inches

I think this answers the questions you were asking, but if it doesn't, please let me know and we'll supply additional info. If we get approval, it's possible that we'll need to order a new blade(s) to get trims that is an exact match.

Hello Sarah & Charles:

Great catch with question on rails/stiles. The sketch may have pushed a misunderstanding to the surface.

We have proposed a single unbroken pane of fixed glass in the new windows. I tried to be clear about that in my oral presentation to you and Charles - apologies for not being clear enough.

My rationale for single pane was: matching exterior wood trim and proportion of windows, but leaving the glass unbroken seemed to me less likely to draw attention to the windows, and to let them blend into the rhythm of existing design. My concern about breaking up glass into panes was that the windows are in drive, and will be seen up close by visitors in drive, and that often attempts to almost "forge" original construction seem to me to not quite work. From the inside of the building (not part of your concern, I realize), the single pane will probably seem less faux.

That said - If the Historical Commission staff will support breaking the windows into 2 or 4 individual panes, and you are uncomfortable supporting single pane (insulated), I'll revise our proposal to match your suggestion and get new shop drawings. I'm flexible and our priority is natural light.

More detail on existing proposal - I've attached the quote we received, with mini-sketch. The colors, trim (colored aluminum) match the other replacement windows we have installed - all by Marvin.

I was looking for dimensions of the stiles and rails that make up the sash (the size of the vertical and horizontal members). If it's going to match the historic window, if you can just document what those dimensions are, that'll be fine. 2 inches, 3 inches?
