Remove the existing painted cedar fence and replace with a new composite (solid cellular PVC) fence by New England Woodworkers to match the dimensions, location, design, and color (Benjamin Moore Black Forest Green) of the existing fence.

All improvements shall be carried out as shown on the plans and specifications submitted by the applicant, except as modified above. Approved plans and specifications are incorporated by reference into this certificate.

This certificate is granted upon the condition that the work authorized herein is commenced within six months after the date of issue. 1. Change exterior paint colors as follows:
Body: Galveston Gray (Benjamin Moore AC-27)
Trim: Sailcloth (Benjamin Moore PM-21)
Shutters: Black Forest Green (Benjamin Moore PM-12)
Door: Cottage Red (Benjamin Moore PM-15)
2. Remove the existing paint from the brick side walls of the house and leave unpainted.
3. Remove the existing front steps and rebuild new front steps 10' 6" wide with brick or fieldstone risers and casing and bluestone treads and optional handrail (at the discretion of the owners).
4. Re-pave the brick walkway in front of the house to match existing running bond pattern.
5. Re-pave the driveway with brick in a running bond pattern.

Approval was granted on the condition that the bluestone treads of the new front steps have a flame finish and that the construction details be reviewed and approved by staff.

All improvements shall be carried out as shown on the plans and specifications submitted by the applicant, except as modified above. Approved plans and specifications are incorporated by reference into this certificate.

This certificate is granted upon the condition that the work authorized herein is commenced within six months after the date of issue. If the work authorized by this certificate is not commenced within six months after the date of issue, or if such work is suspended in significant part for a period of one year after the time the work is commenced, then this certificate shall expire and be of no further effect; provided that, for cause, one or more extensions of time, for periods not exceeding six months each, may be allowed in writing by the Chair.

The logo is to be located as shown in the rendering by Honan Sign Co. dated March 12, 2017 but approval was granted on the condition that the placement of the lettering be moved below the logo.

Approval is granted subject to review of construction details by the staff.
