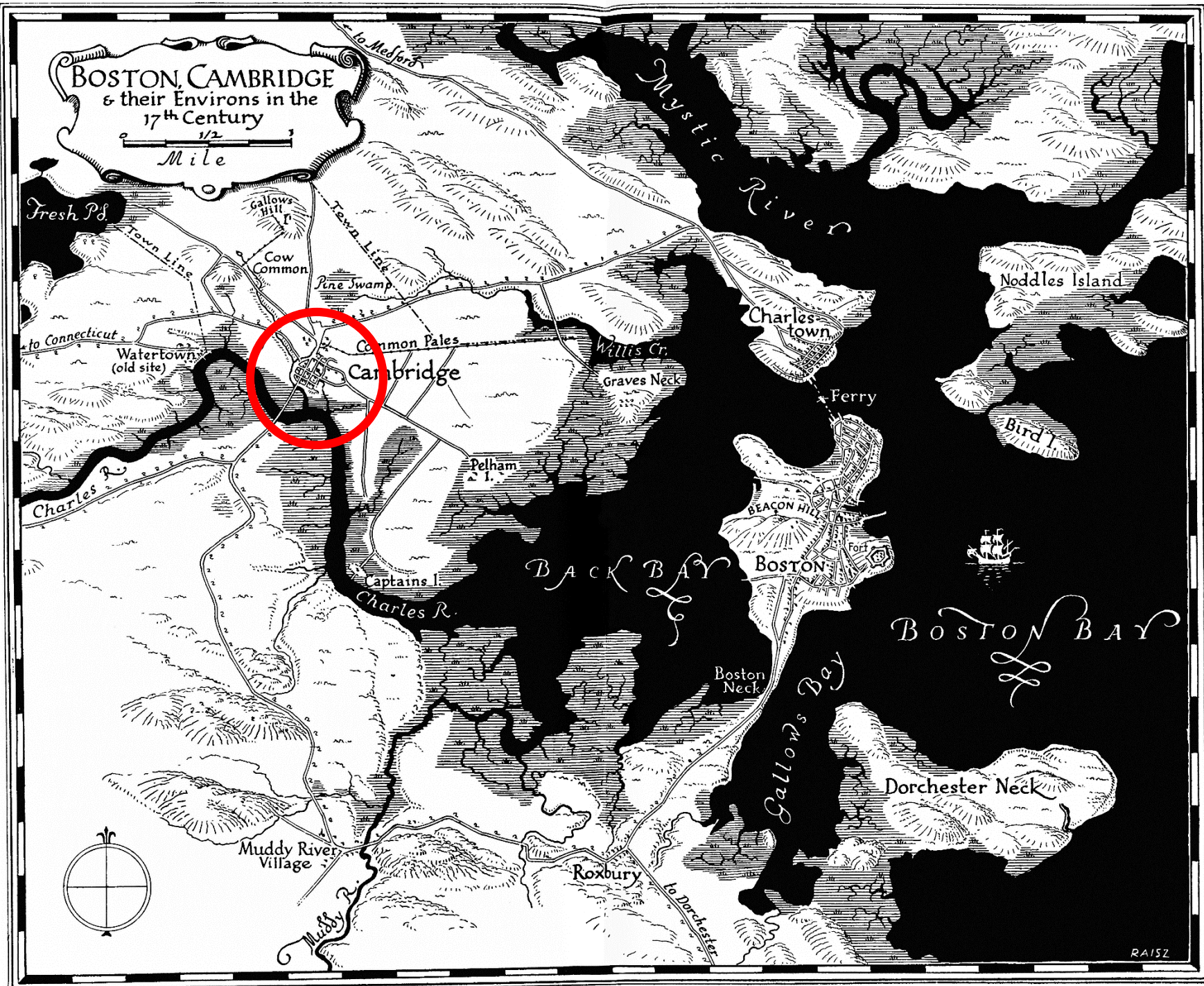


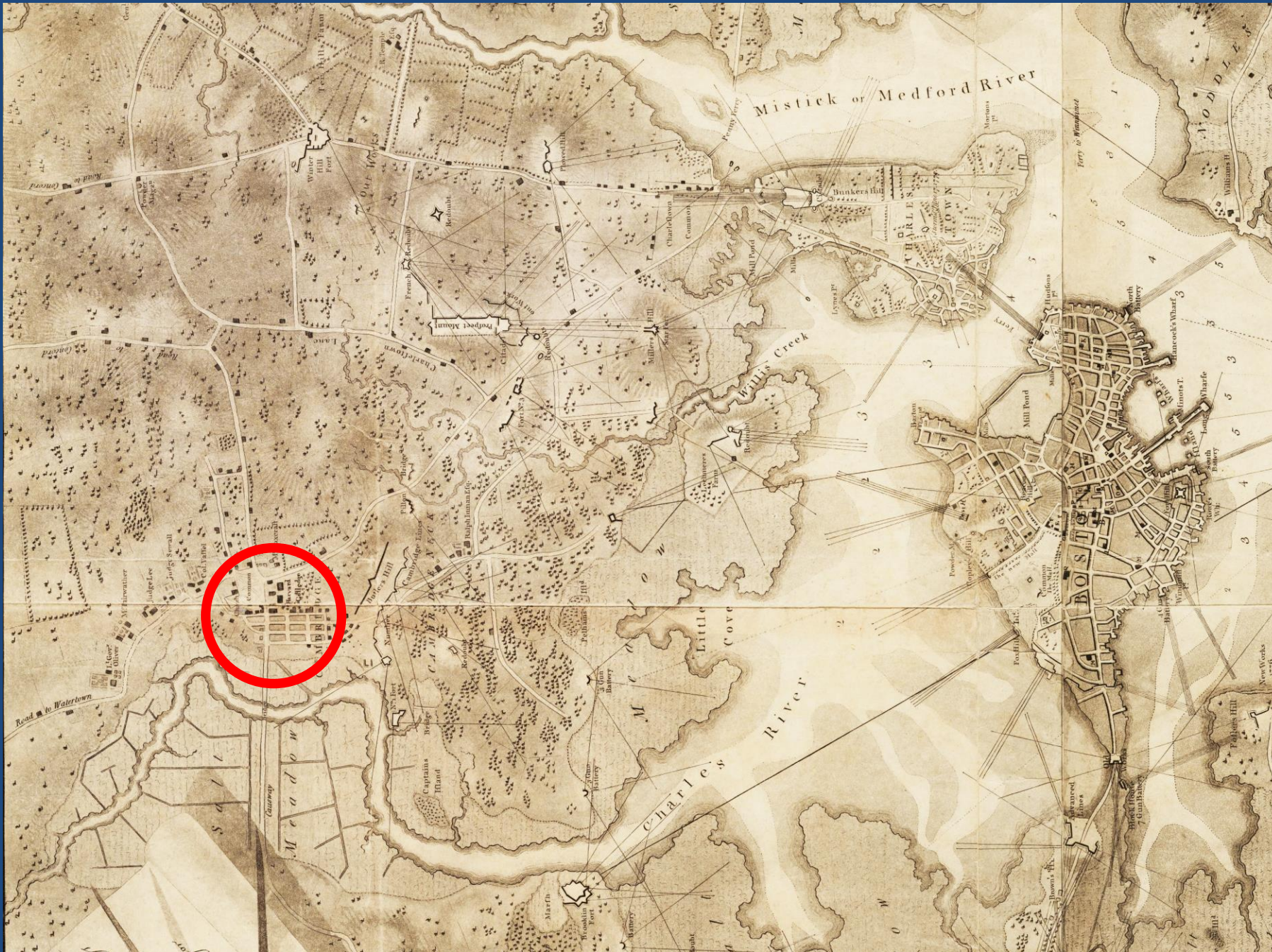

Reconstructed plan of Cambridge and environs in the 17th century





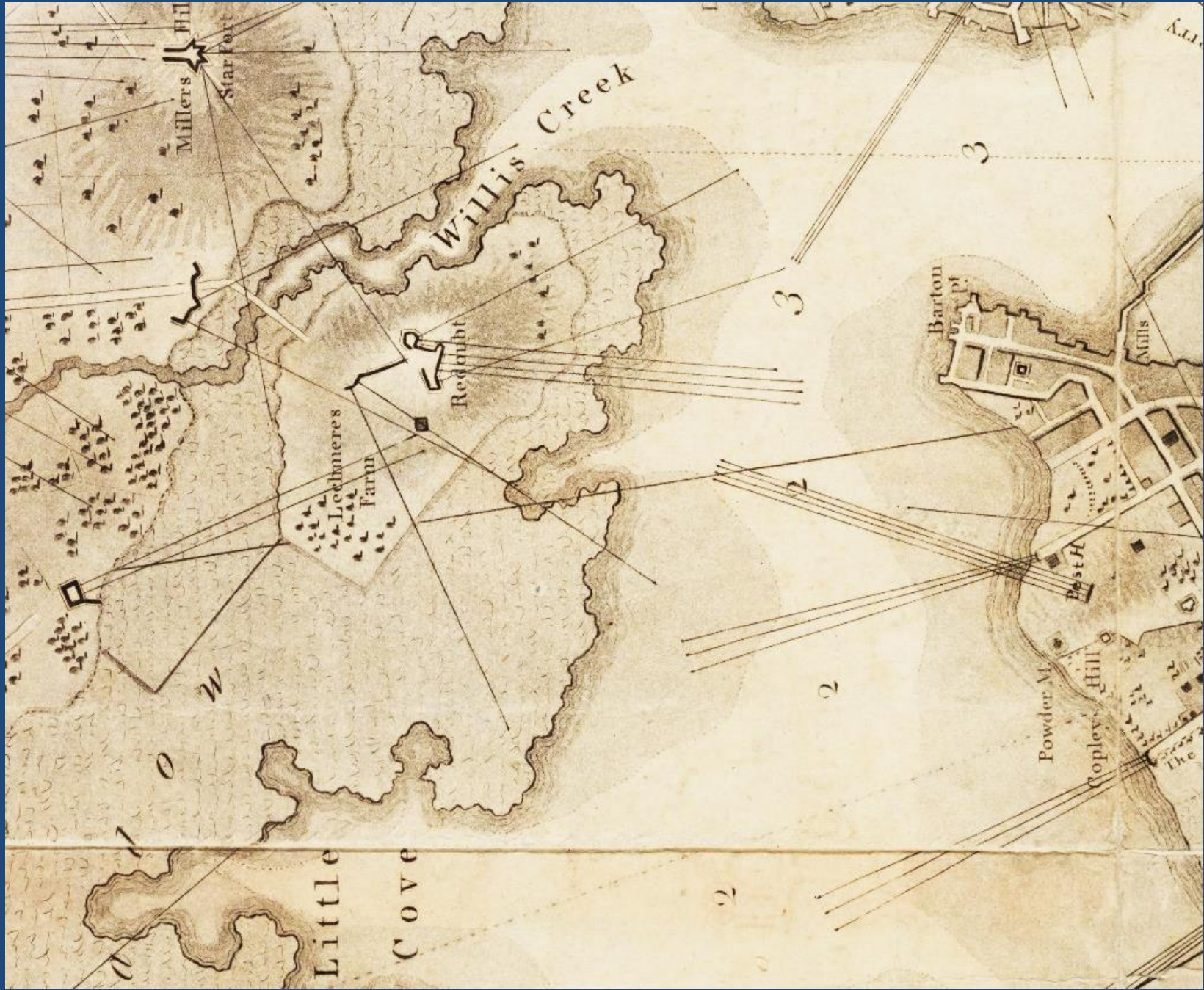

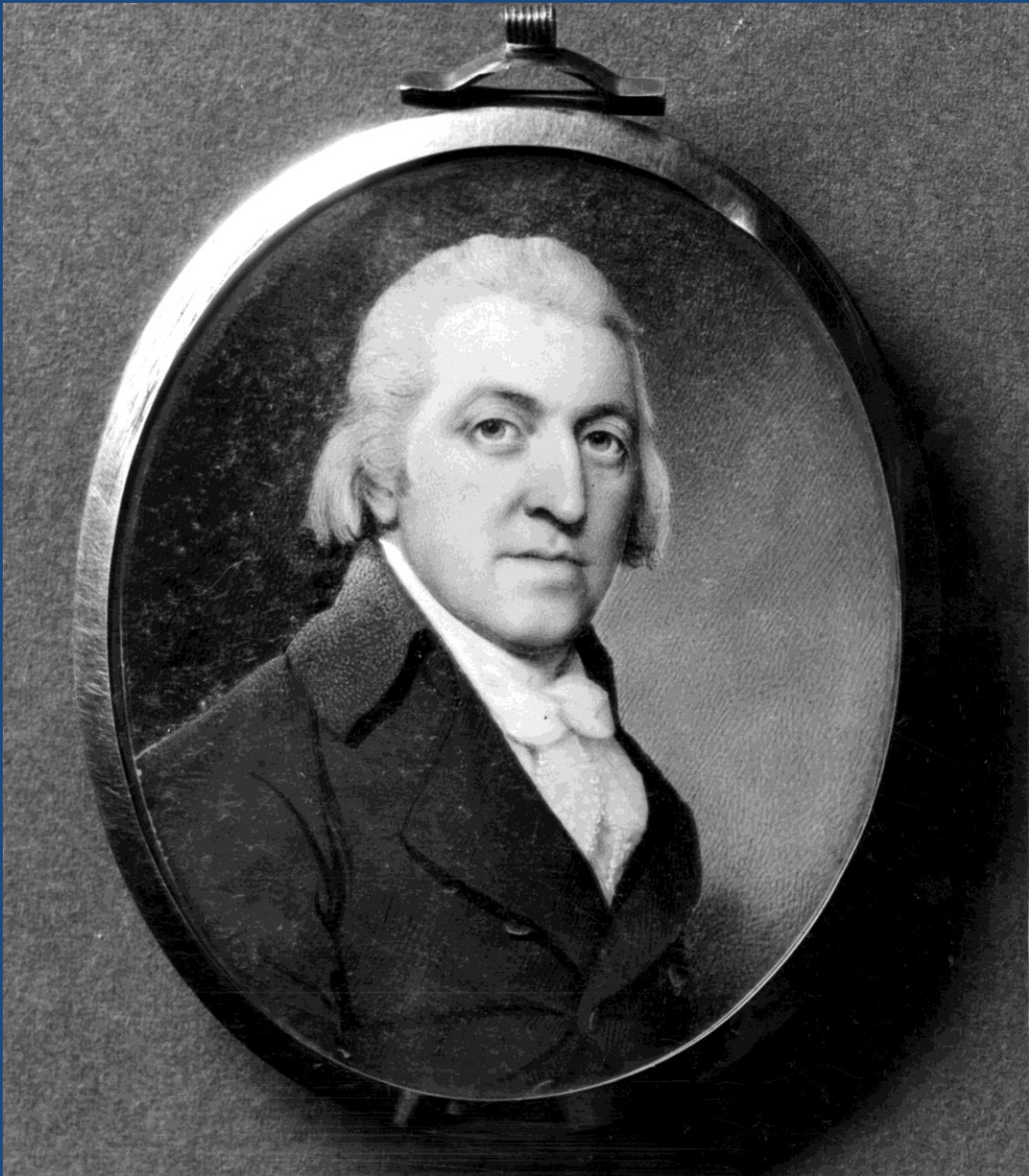




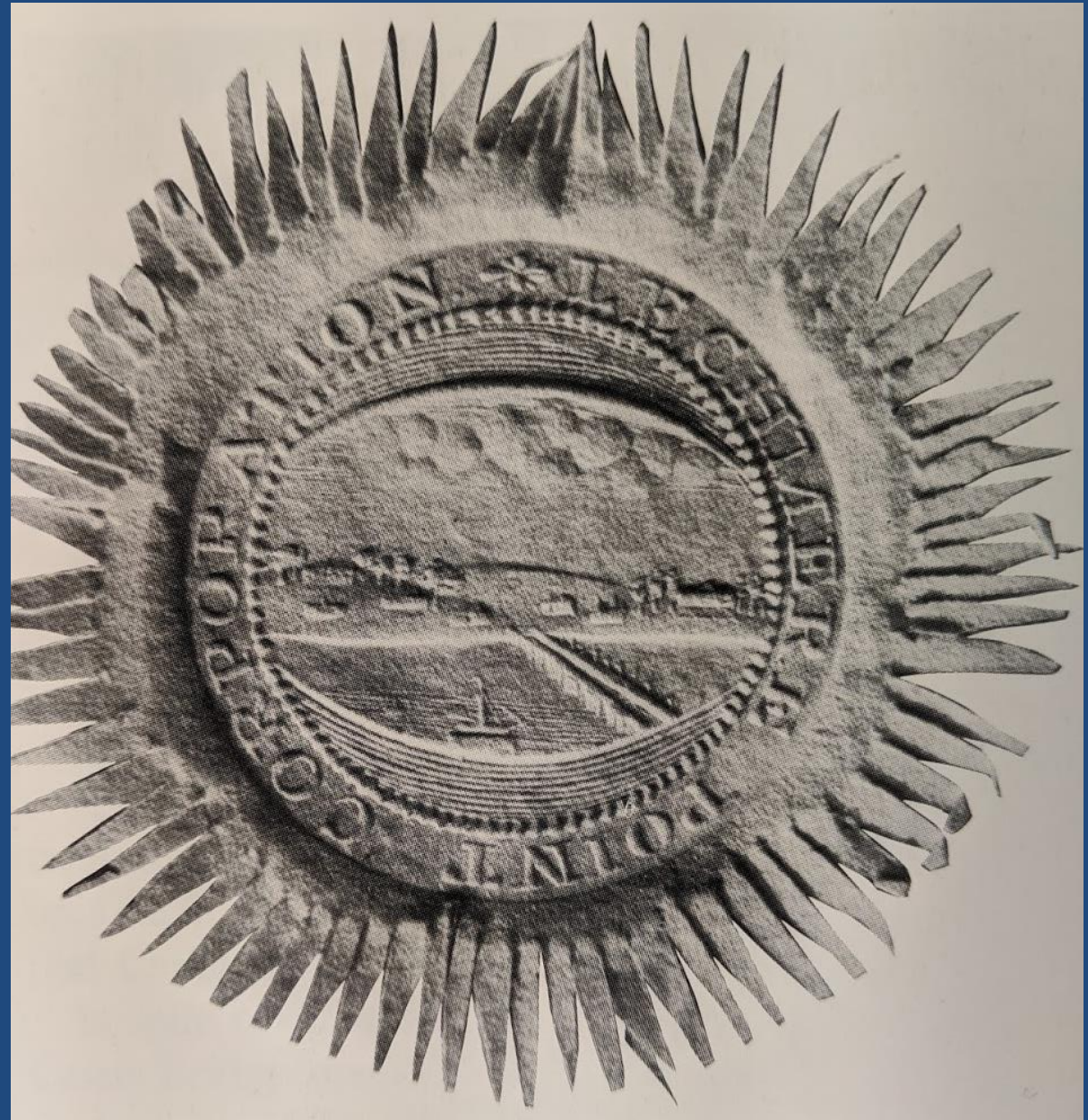


West Boston (Longfellow) Bridge, 1793



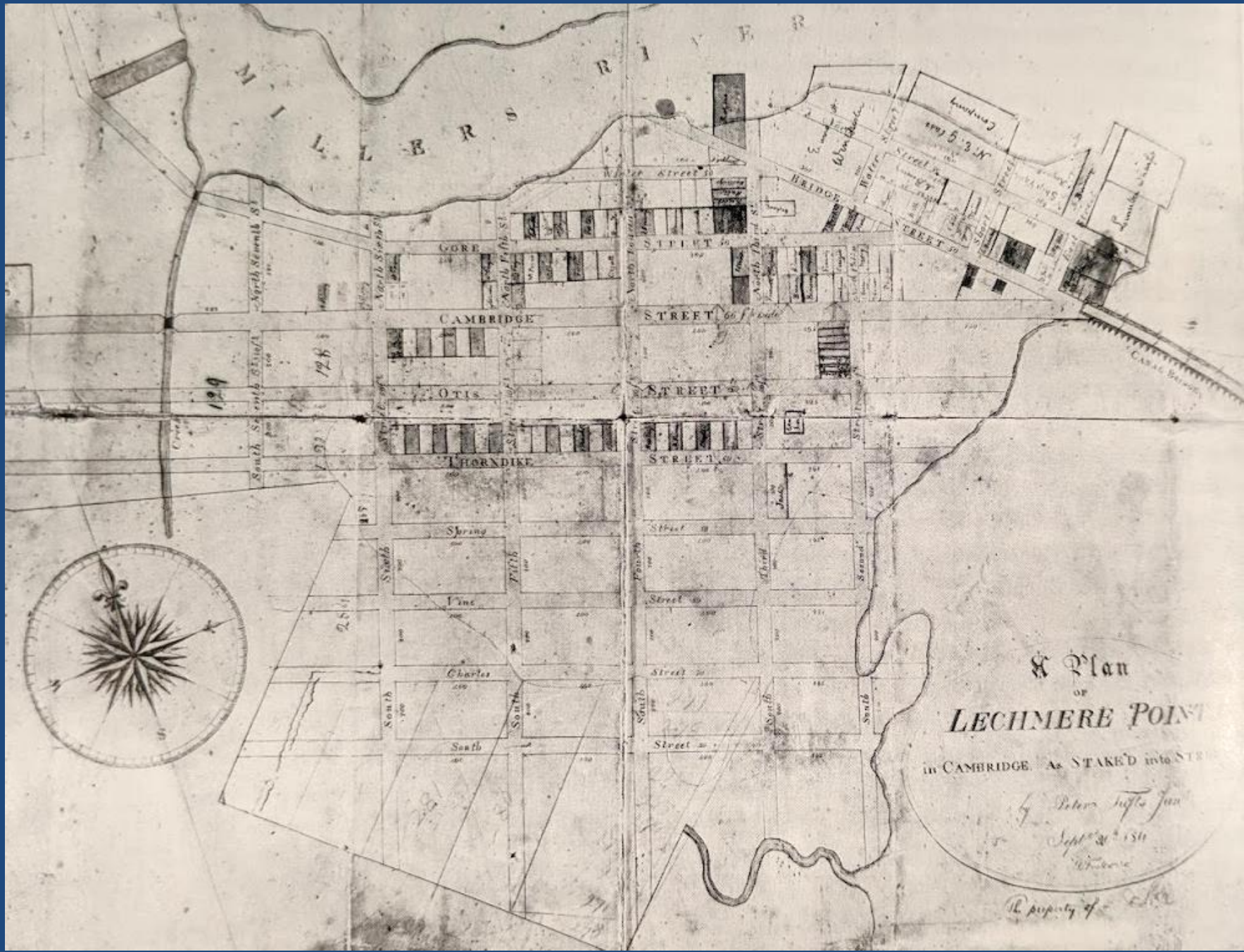

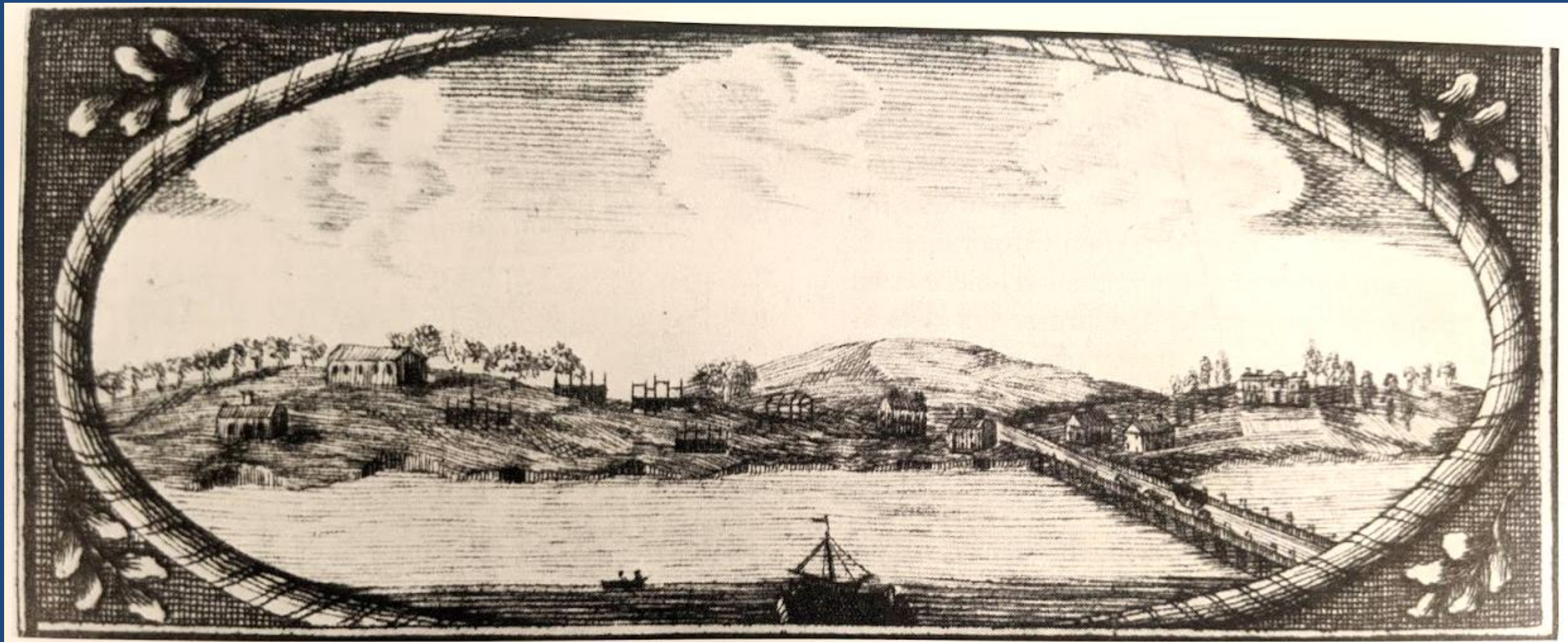
Seal of the Lechmere Point Corporation, 1814





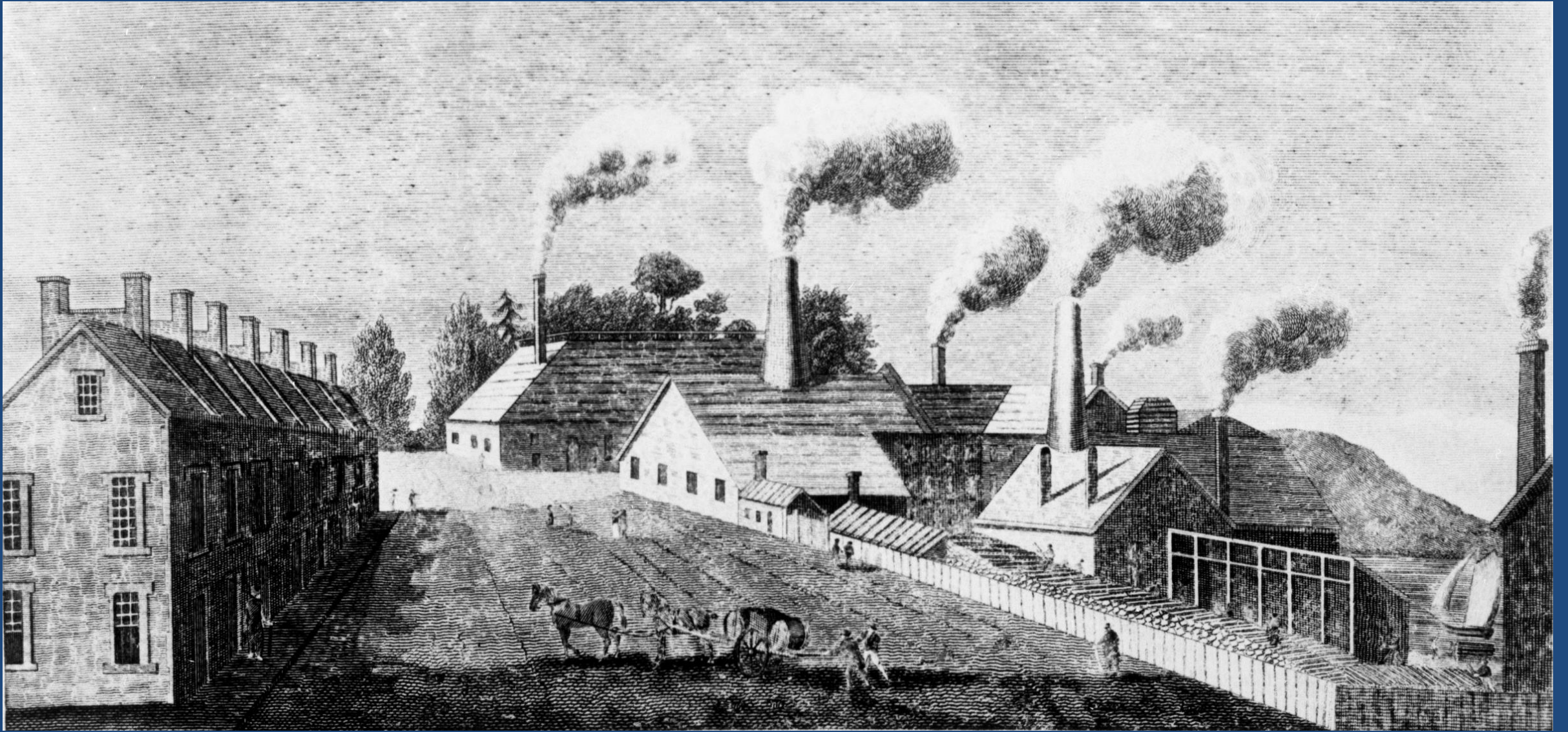

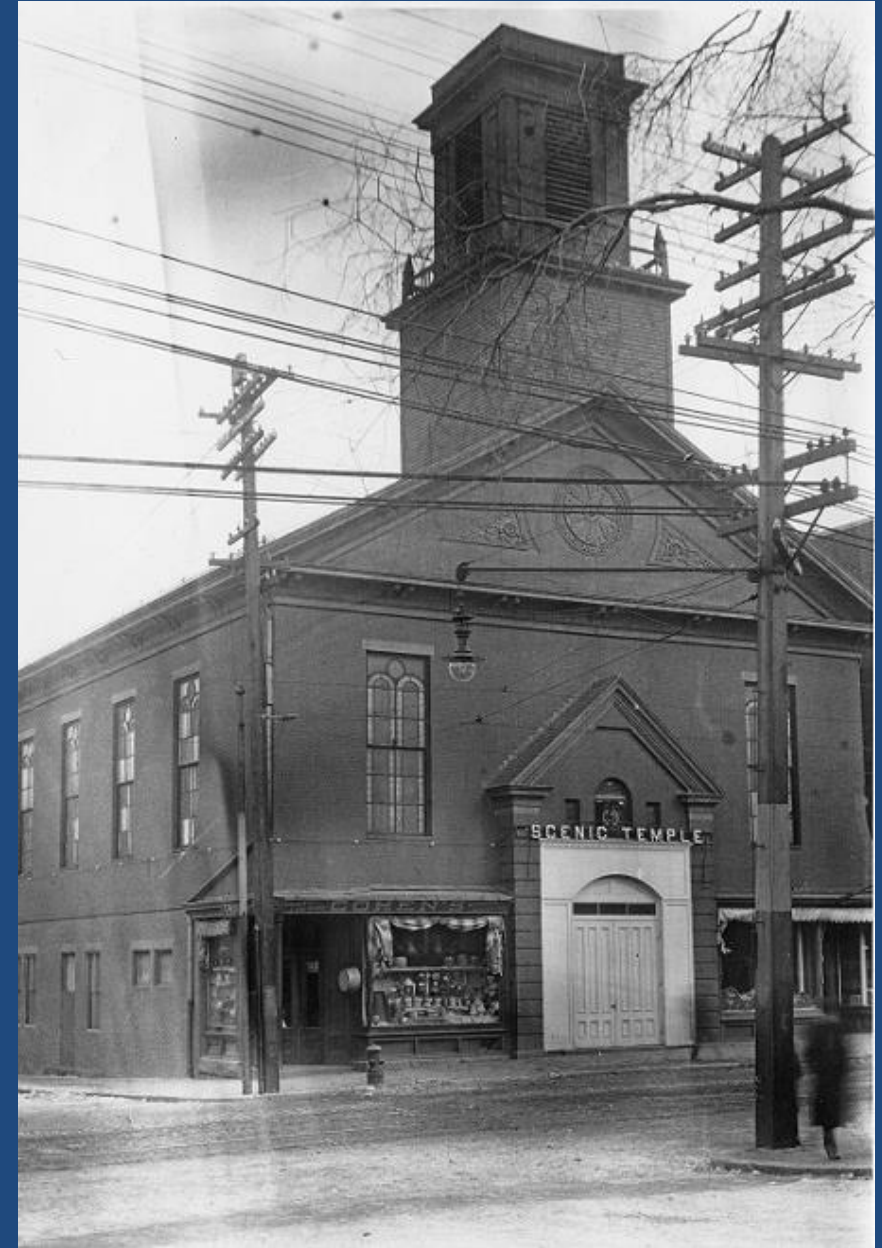

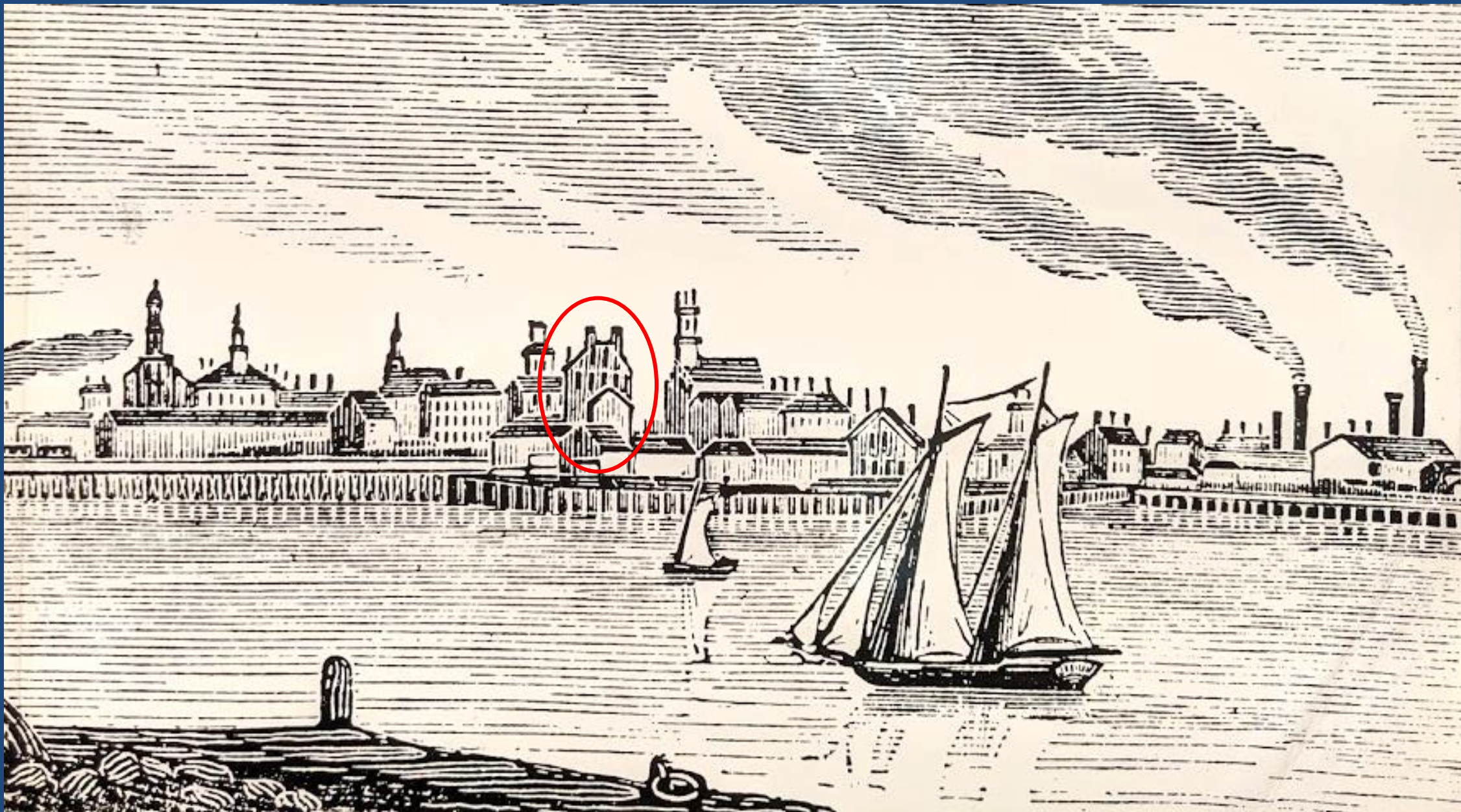

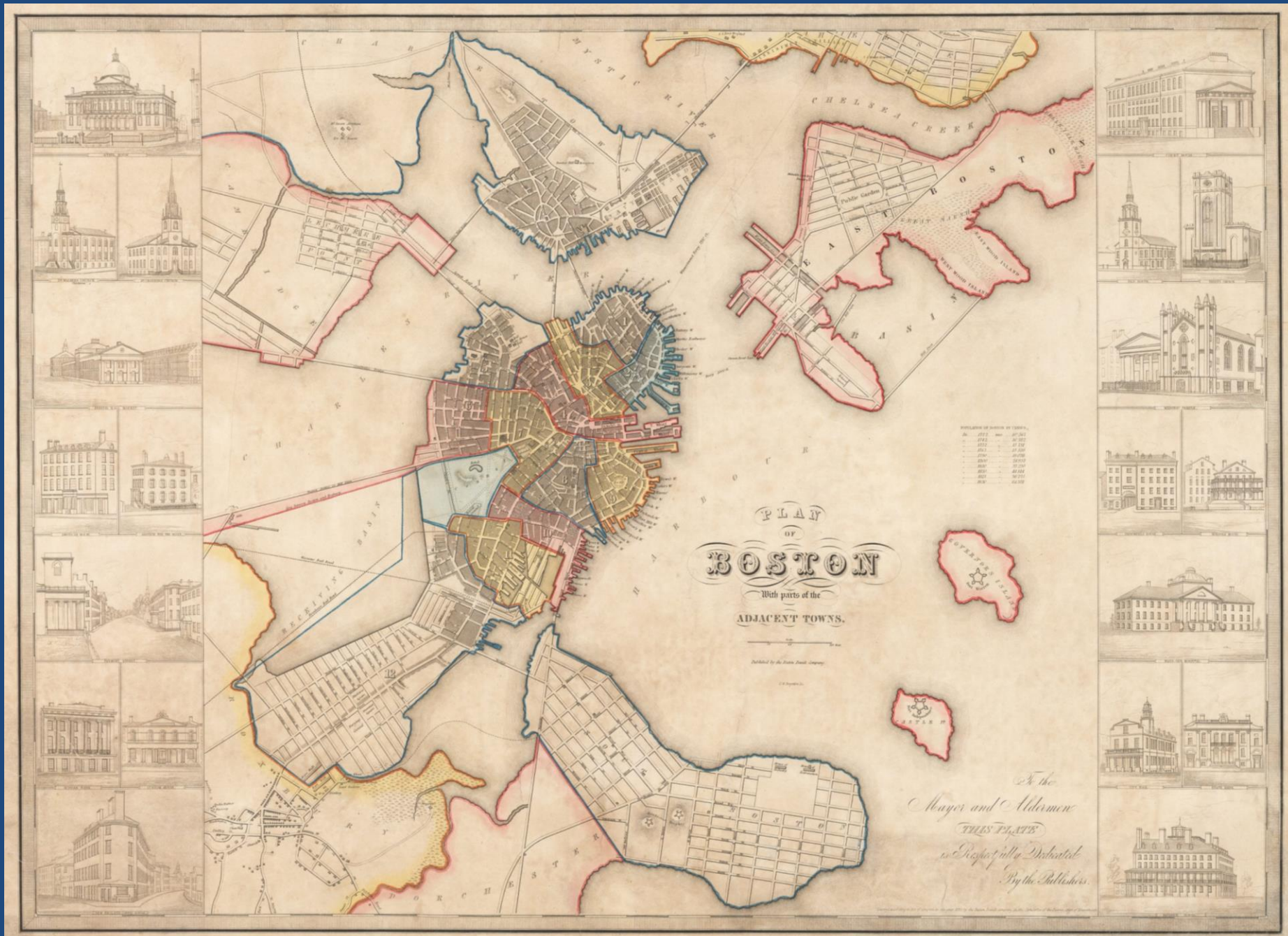
