NOTICE OF BOARD VOTE - ENTERTAINMENT ANNUAL LICENSES

On March 1, 2021, the Board of License Commissioners (the "Board") during an administrative meeting voted (3-0) to remove the newspaper advertisement requirement for annual entertainment license applications, including those seeking to add live entertainment. The Board further voted the applicant will need to notify abutters seven days prior to the hearing before the Board to allow abutters to attend the hearing or provide their comments to the Board prior to the hearing. Abutters will be those on the front, back, sides, above (for mixed use buildings), and across the street. Abutters residing in condominiums/mixed-use buildings may be notified via the condominium association or management company so long as the notice details that the association/company needs to notify all residents/occupants therein. An affidavit of notice to abutters will have to be submitted by the applicant.
