RE: Concord Ave Sewer Separation Project

FINAL PAVING NOTICE including BUS DETOURS and NIGHT WORK:

Dear Residents,

The City's contractor, P. Gioioso and Sons, Inc., is scheduled to begin final paving throughout the Concord Project area (see list of streets below) on **Friday, June 9th, through Friday, June 16th**. Please note, paving is weather dependent. Unless otherwise noted below, this work is scheduled to begin at 7AM, and crews will make every effort to open the roadway as soon as possible. **Traffic detours will be in place** for this work. The westbound only buses will be detoured during the paving of Concord Avenue. Please follow all detour signs. Any changes to the schedule below will be communicated by calling (617) 498-4704 for updates.

Final Paving Schedule:

- **NIGHT WORK:** Friday, June 9th, 7PM-5AM (Friday PM into Saturday AM)
 - **Garden Street** (Ivy to Walden)
 - **Walden Street** (Concord to Garden)
 - **Concord Avenue intersection** (at Huron)

- Monday, June 12th - **westbound bus detour (24 hours/day)** – see figure on reverse side
 - **Birch Street**
 - **Concord Avenue** (Birch to Huron, south side of street)

- Tuesday, June 13th - **westbound bus detour (24 hours/day)** – see figure on reverse side
 - **Concord Avenue** (Birch to Huron, north side of street)
 - **Fern Street**

- Wednesday, June 14th
 - **Alpine Street** (Concord to Field)
 - **Chilton Street** (Concord to Field)
 - **Field Street** (Alpine to Fayerweather)
 - **Garden Street** (Alpine to Ivy)
 - **Hazel Street**

- Thursday, June 15th
 - **Bay State Road** (New Street to Alpine)
 - **Corporal Burns Road**

- Friday, June 16th
 - **Copley Street**
 - **Fayerweather** (Walden to Concord)
 - **Ivy Street**

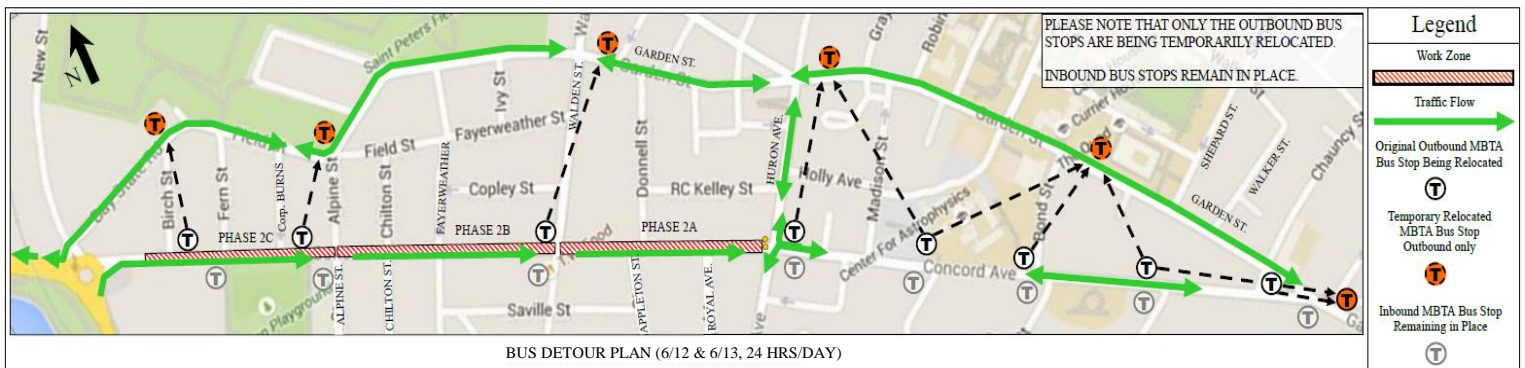


NOTE: Paving dates are weather dependent.

- Daily paving updates will be provided by calling (617) 498-4704

What to Expect During Road Paving Activities:

- Previously used **traffic detours will be in place**, as needed, for the dates noted above. Please pay attention to all detour signs. For real-time traffic updates, we encourage you to download the free WAZE app to your smartphone, which many residents have found helpful for navigating around work zones.
- There will be a westbound MBTA bus route detour, 24 hours/day, on Monday, June 12th, and Tuesday, June 13th. See the figure below for more details.
- There will be **No Parking** allowed on the above streets **starting at 7am**. We ask you to pay attention to all “No Parking” signs, which will be posted 48-hours in advance of this work. If you anticipate leaving your car for more than 24 hours, we encourage you to make arrangements with your neighbors, should it need to be moved.
- There will be **No Vehicle Access** to/from driveways starting at **7am** for the dates noted above, or between 7PM and 5AM for any listed nightwork.
- Application of final pavement markings will occur at a later date, after the final pavement work has been completed. Temporary markings on major routes will be installed as needed in the interim.
- Pedestrian traffic will be unimpeded along the existing sidewalks, with some restrictions at crossings.
- The roadway(s) will be closed starting at **7am**, but crews will make every effort to open the roadway as soon as possible.
- Emergency vehicles will have access to the roadways at all times.
- City services will continue uninterrupted.
