## **NOTICE: Temporary Traffic Pattern Change** **Huron Ave (Manassas to Royal)**

Dear Resident,

In preparation for upcoming Huron Avenue roadway reconstruction as part of the Huron B- Alewife Sewer Separation Project, the City will conduct a traffic analysis on **Huron Ave (Manassas to Royal)** on **Thursday, July 14<sup>th</sup>**. During this analysis, traffic on Huron Avenue, between Manassas and Royal, will be shifted to the north side of Huron Ave and the south side will be temporarily closed. We will post “**No Parking**” signs along this stretch of roadway to facilitate this traffic pattern shift on Thursday, July 14<sup>th</sup>. Access to all side streets and driveways will be maintained during this time.

We ask that you please pay attention to the “no parking” signs, which will be posted a minimum of 24 hours in advance. This activity is anticipated to take a few hours to complete and parking will be restored as soon as possible.
