APPLETON STREET ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION

Starts Week of May 8

Dear Resident,

The City's contractor, P Gioioso & Sons, will begin reconstructing the roadway on Appleton St (Brattle St to Highland St) during the week of May 8, weather permitting. We expect the road work to take 10 days to complete.

Vehicle access in and out of properties will be somewhat limited during work hours while crews perform the roadway work. Please plan vehicle trips accordingly.

Project Schedule

- During the week of May 8, crews will begin roadway reconstruction on Appleton St. We expect the road work to take 10 days to complete.
- We anticipate crews to pave Appleton St before May 26th, weather permitting (binder paving only; final paving will take place once sidewalks are complete)
- When all the roadway work is complete, crews will begin sidewalk reconstruction.

What to Expect during Roadway Reconstruction

- Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM.
- Appleton St, from Brattle St to Highland St, will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters with intermittent detours.
- Vehicle access in and out of properties will be somewhat limited during work hours. Please plan vehicle and parking trips accordingly.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
