LOWELL STREET ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION

Begins Monday, October 17

As part of ongoing improvements, the City's contractor, D'Allessandro Corp., will begin reconstructing the surface of the roadway on Lowell St on **Monday, October 17**, to prepare the street for paving. Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM, and Lowell St will be closed to through traffic, but open to abutters. We expect the work to take 2-3 days to complete.

What to Expect During Roadway Reconstruction

- Crews will begin on Lowell St at the Brattle St end, and work their way towards Mt. Auburn St.
- The road will be closed to through traffic during work hours, and reopened at the end of the work day. Access to properties will be maintained, and all sidewalks will remain open.
- There cannot be any cars parked on the street during this work. Please be sure to check "No Parking" signs to avoid being ticketed and towed.
- Paving will take place in the next few weeks. An additional notice confirming the paving date will follow.
