CONCORD AVE FINAL PAVING

Saturday, November 5 and Monday, November 7

6:00 AM to 7:00 PM-Saturday

7:00 AM to 7:00 PM-Monday

The City's contractor, C.J. Mabardy, will pave Concord Ave from the Alewife Rotary to Blanchard Rd on ***Saturday, November 5 and Monday, November 7*** (weather permitting). Work hours for the paving operation will be **6:00 AM to 7:00 PM on Saturday, and 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM on Monday.**

Traffic Management (please see detour map on reverse side)

On both days, during paving operations, crews and police details will maintain westbound traffic only on Concord Ave. Eastbound traffic will be detoured. On Saturday, the intersection of Blanchard Rd and Concord Ave will be closed from 7:00 AM to 12:00 PM.

What to Expect During Paving

- The northern half (Smith Place side) of the street will be paved on Saturday and the southern half (Fresh Pond Reservation side) will be paved on Monday.
- Vehicle access in and out of properties will be restricted during paving, particularly on Saturday. Please plan vehicle trips accordingly. Emergency vehicles will be allowed through as needed.
- MBTA buses will be relocated during paving as shown on the detour map.
- Signage and police details will be in place to assist neighbors, but drivers are encouraged to seek alternate routes.
- Paving is weather dependent, and may be rescheduled due to rain.
