OXFORD STREET CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Sidewalk Reconstruction Starts Thursday, March 21

Dear Oxford Street Neighbor,

On Thursday, March 21 (weather permitting), the City's contractor, Newport Construction, will remobilize on Oxford St to begin sidewalk reconstruction between Forest St and Garfield/Eustis Sts. We expect the work to take about 1 month to complete.

Project Schedule

- Crews will first install new sidewalks on the south (odd) side of Oxford St, between Forest St and Garfield St. The work will take about 2 weeks to complete.
- Once this section is complete, crews will move to the north (even) side of Oxford St between Forest St and Eustis St. The work in this area will take about 2 weeks to complete.
- After sidewalk reconstruction on Oxford St is complete, crews will pave the roadway and plant new trees.

What to Expect during Sidewalk Reconstruction

- Oxford St will remain open during sidewalk work.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times.
- Pedestrian and vehicle access into properties will be maintained at all times, but may be restricted in certain ways.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
- City services will continue uninterrupted.
