Eversource Gas and Divco West, the developer of Cambridge Crossing (formerly known as NorthPoint), are currently upgrading utilities on Gore St between Monsignor O'Brien Highway and Warren St.

Following this construction, the City will reconstruct the watermain, replace any lead services, and reconstruct the roadway and sidewalks on Gore St. *This is an opportunity to improve Gore St for residents, as well as for people walking and biking along the street.* The City has received initial requests from residents for
