## MAIN STREET CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

*Water Work Begins Friday, 9/12*

Dear Kendall Square Neighbor,

On **Friday, September 12**, the city's contractor, Newport Construction, will begin preparations for water main lining work on Main St, from Ames St to Wadsworth St. The water lining operation will be ongoing for the next 3 weeks.

### PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Starting September 12, crews will setup a water main by-pass on Main St, between Dock St and Hayward St, in preparation for the lining. The lining is expected to take about 3 weeks to complete.
- The Third St Connector construction at Main St and Third St/Broadway will continue during the water work.
- We will continue to provide updates as the construction progresses.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

- During the water main lining, crews will place a water by-pass pipe in the gutter line on the north side of Main St between Dock St and Hayward St. This will remain in place until the lining is complete. All impacted properties have been notified.
- MBTA Bus, shuttle and trolley schedules on Main St will not be affected by the water main lining; however stops may be temporarily shifted at times.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
