

ROSELAND STREET ROADWAY RECONSTRUCTION

Starts Tuesday, April 18

Dear Resident,

The City's contractor, P Gioioso & Sons, will begin reconstructing the roadway on Roseland St on Tuesday, April 18, weather permitting. We expect the road work to take 4 days to complete.

Vehicle access in and out of properties will be somewhat limited during work hours while crews perform the roadway milling. Please plan vehicle trips accordingly.

Project Schedule

- On Tuesday, April 18, crews will begin roadway reconstruction on Roseland St.
- We expect the road work to take 4 days to complete.
- Once the work on Roseland St is complete, crews will move to Newport Rd to perform roadway reconstruction.
- We anticipate crews to pave Roseland St and Newport Rd on Friday, April 28, weather permitting (binder paving only; final paving will take place once sidewalks are complete)
- When all the roadway work is complete, crews will begin sidewalk reconstruction.
- Please note, crews will not work on Monday, April 17 in observance of the Patriots' Day holiday.

What to Expect during Roadway Reconstruction

- Work hours will be 7 AM to 4 PM.
- Vehicle access in and out of properties will be somewhat limited during work hours. Please plan vehicle and parking trips accordingly.
- "No Parking" signs will be posted; please be sure to check dates/times.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times.
