How Does DHSP Lottery Work?

- The DHSP lottery is for seats in Community School Summer Programs and CYP Summer Programs (at Cambridge youth centers)
- All families should fill out DHSP online application during lottery window: Feb 1st Mar 3rd.
- When you apply to the DHSP Summer Lottery, you create an account on Viewpoint (if you don't already have one). If your child is offered a seat at a summer progarm, you will be given instructions on how to accept the seat through Trax (the city enrollment system)
- After the application window closes (Mar 3rd), spots are allocated to families who applied, with priority given to applicants from low-income households.
- The week of March 25th, you will receive an email stating that "a letter has been issued to your Viewpoint account." This letter will share whether your child has been offered a seat or added to the Waiting Pool. You must accept your seat within 7 days.
- To accept your offer, follow the link in your offer letter to fill out your information in Trax.
- If your child was placed in the Waiting Pool, they will remain in the Pool for their preferred sites. Families stay in waiting pool for their preferred site unless they contact DHSP directly.
- For 6-8th graders: we encourage you to apply even if the Mar 3rd application deadline has passed. You will automatically be added to the Waiting Pool, but there are usually still seats open for middle schoolers after the first lottery round. Another round of offers will happen in May.
- **Need assistance?** DHSP staff are available for in-person assistance at 51 Inman St, on the 3rd floor on Mondays, 5-7:30pm (on Feb 5th, Feb 12th and Feb 26th) during the lottery window.

What About CPS Summer Programs?

- CPS runs **SOARS** program for **K-4th graders** and **Summer Scholars Program for 5-7th graders**, in addition to **ELL programs** and **Extended School Year (ESY) programs**. Students are referred to these programs by school staff. Programs will run July 8 Aug 2nd.
- Families will receive invites from the schools in March. Ask your family liaison later this spring.

Advice on Applying to Summer Camps

- Certain weeks of summer fill faster than others, even for programs with rolling "open until full" deadlines; keep track of registration start dates.
- The youngest age groups tend to fill fastest.
- Apply even if you think your child may be referred to a CPS program; you can decline later.
- Apply for the whole summer if you are unsure what weeks you need. You can decline sessions you no longer need later in the process.
- Join waitlists if you can; they move at different speeds and can give you more options.
- These are not the only options consider half day and specialty camps too!
